




Rick sits on the dock. He can see trash on the dock.

"I see trash," says Mom, "The dock is not beautiful."




But, Rick thinks the dock IS beautiful.



“I think I can make you see that the dock is beautiful,” says Rick.




“How will you fix the dock?”
asks Mom. Rick thinks.






Rick runs back to the dock.
