Before Reading:


- Bugs are not the same thing as insects, but this book uses the word “bugs” to refer to insects.

After Reading:


- Find the page where the bug is eating.

- How many insects live in the world? Ask your teacher to look it up!








A bug sips.


A bug sits on a dog.
