

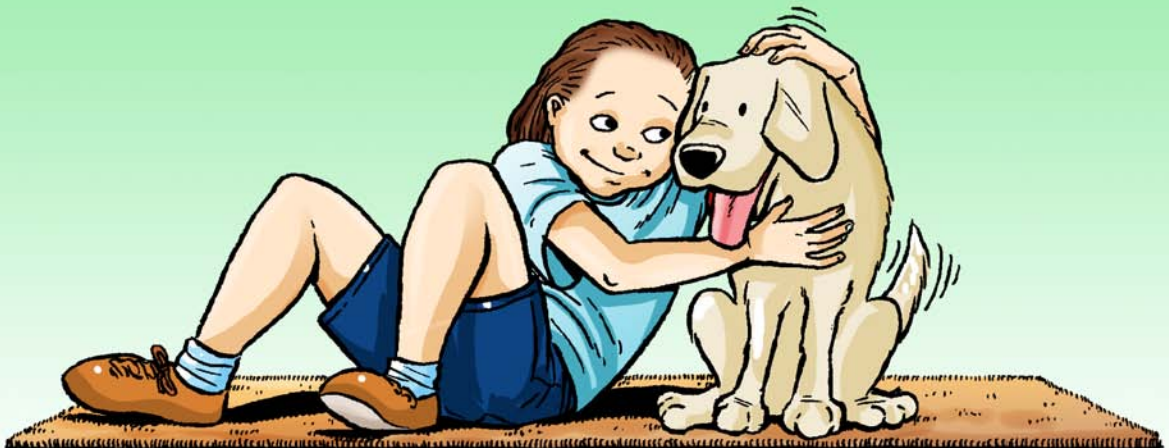

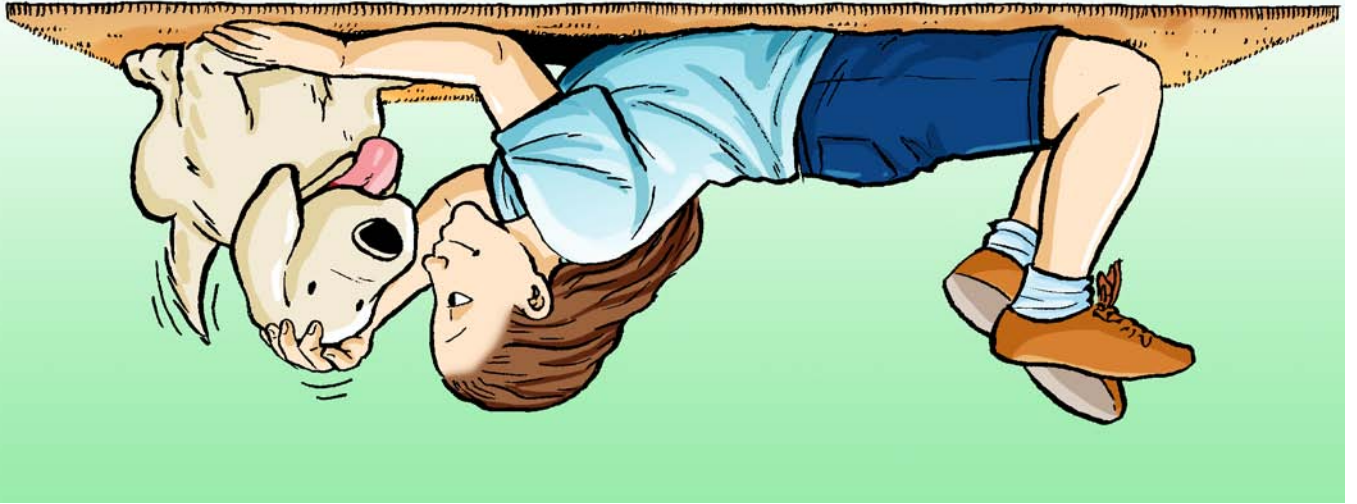

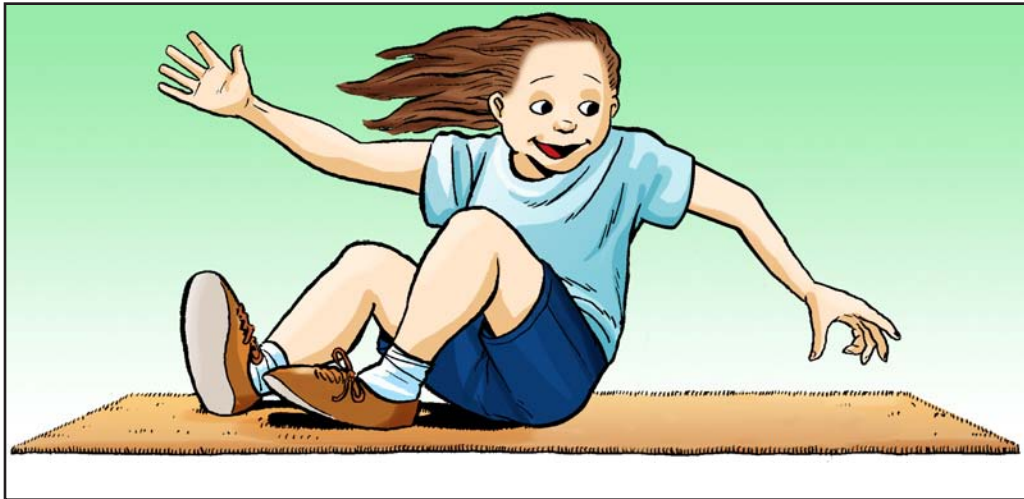

Words with new phonic element *at, mat, tan, pat, sat, tap*

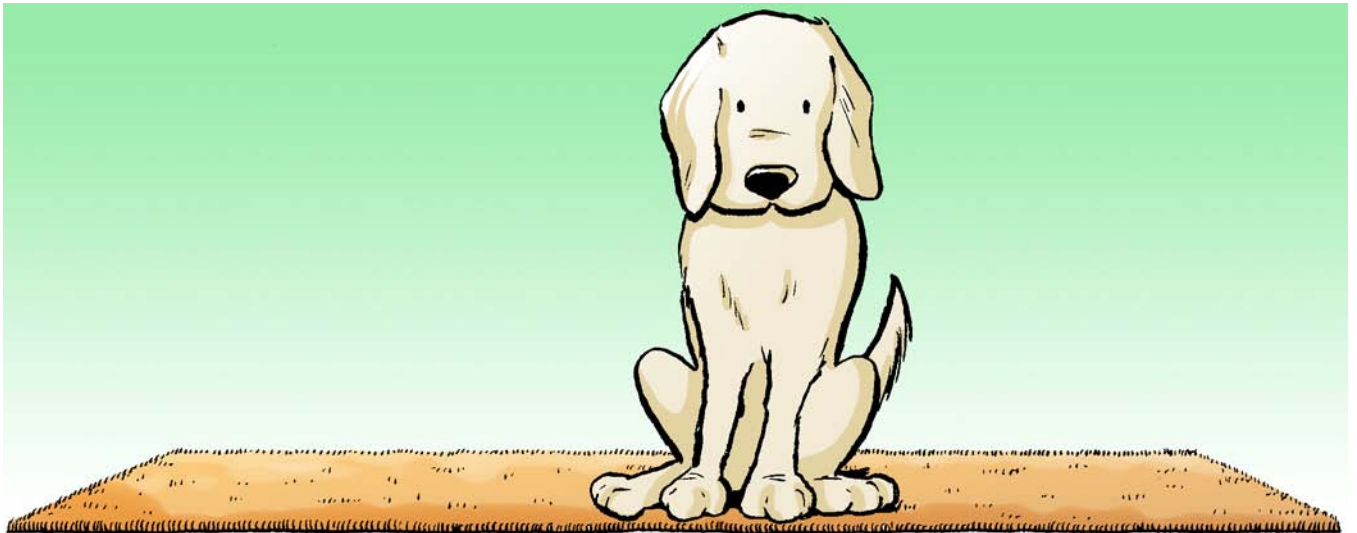
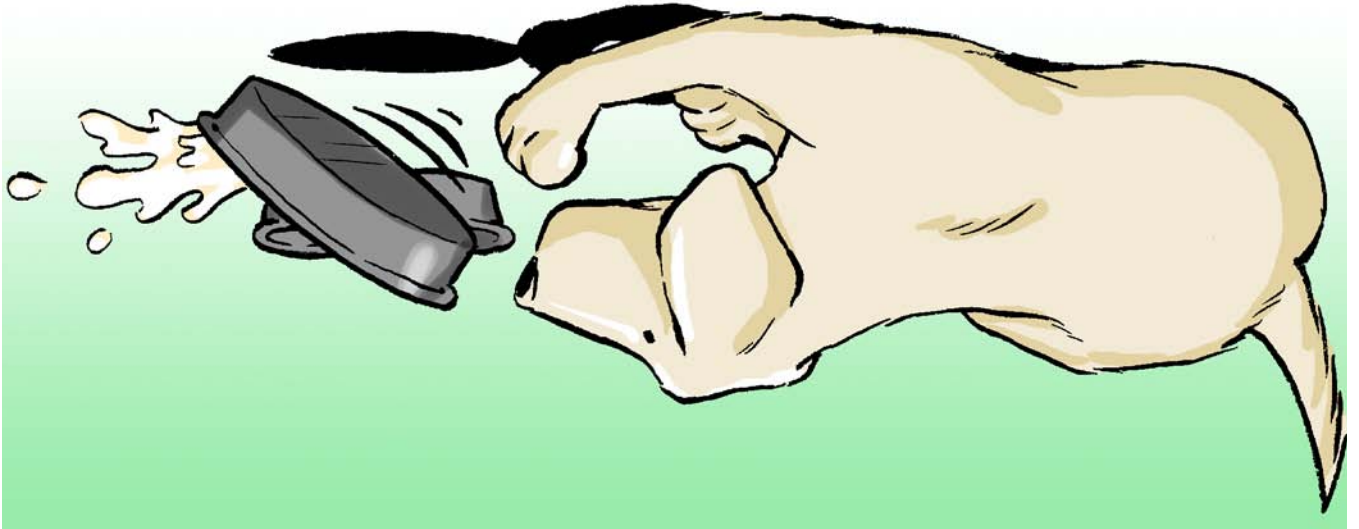
Reviewed phonic elements *n, a, p, m, s*

Reviewed high-frequency words *a, get, on, the*

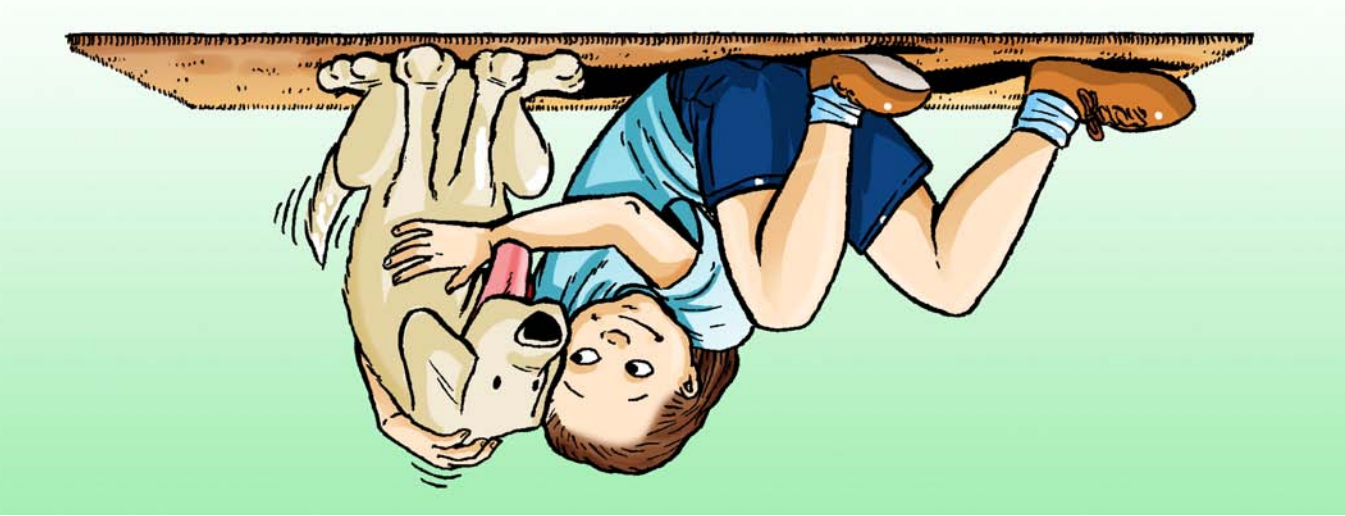
Special consideration inflectional ending *-s*
