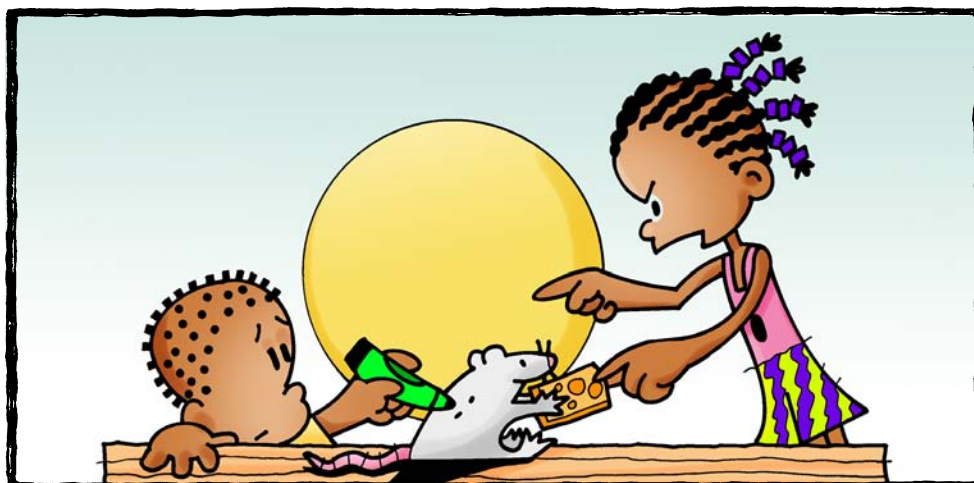

inflectional ending *-s*



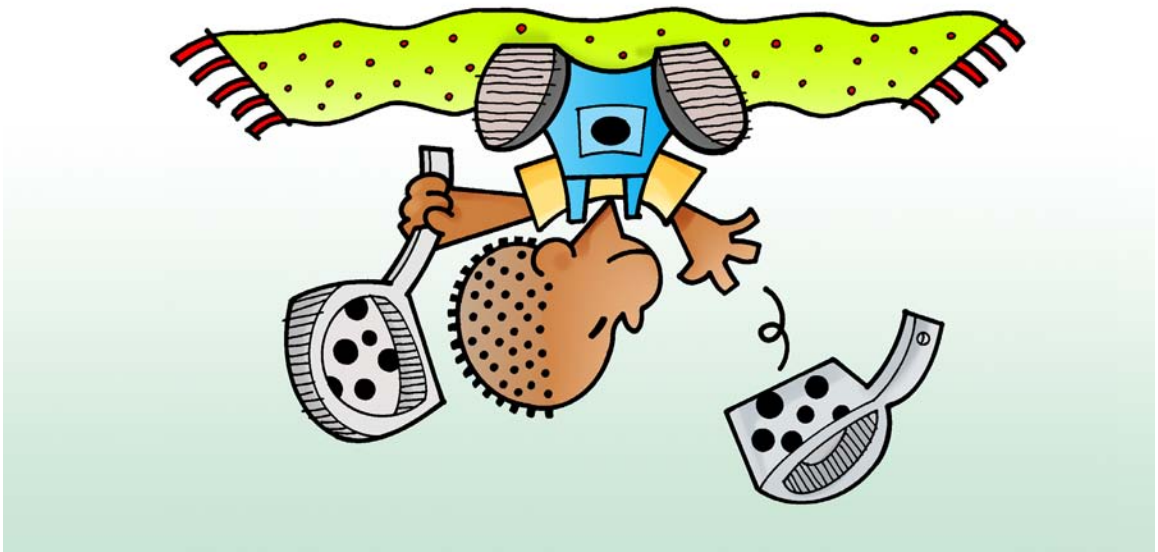
Don sees dots.

Sam and Nan.

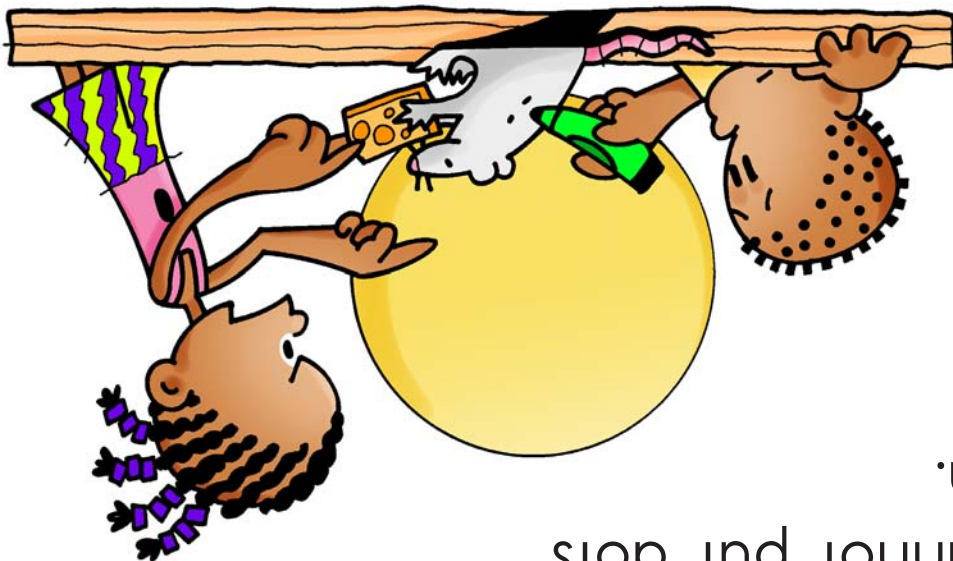




Don put dots on a top.
