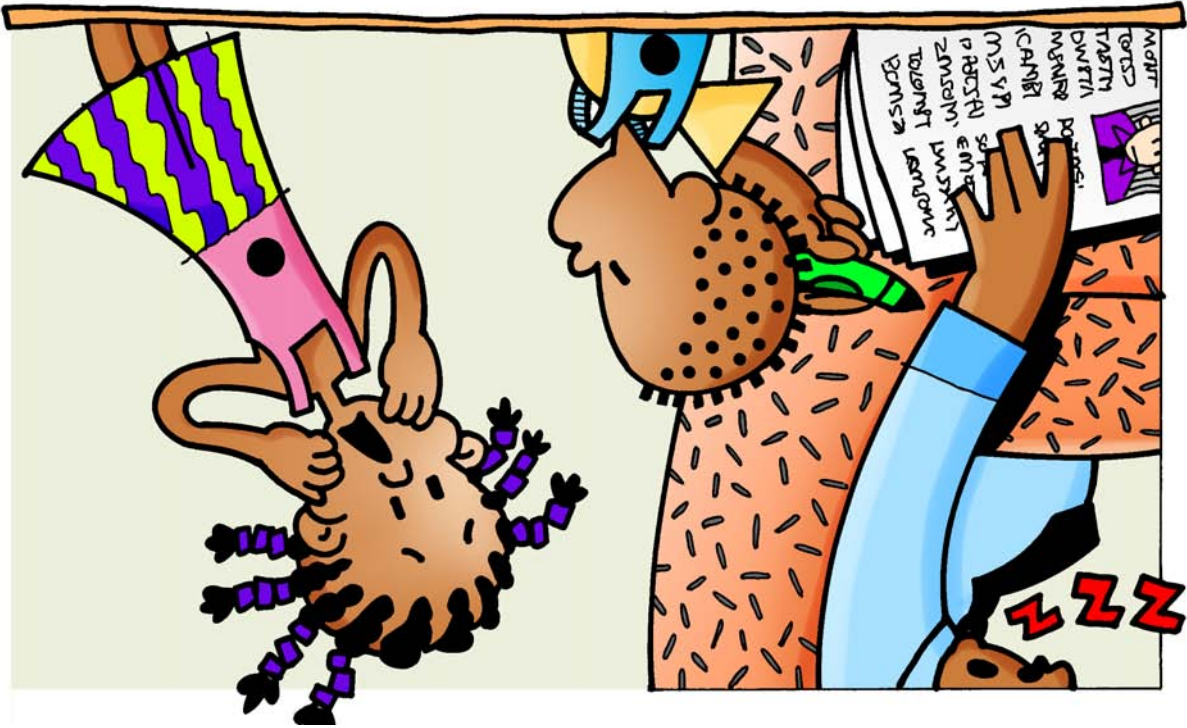

Don is sad.

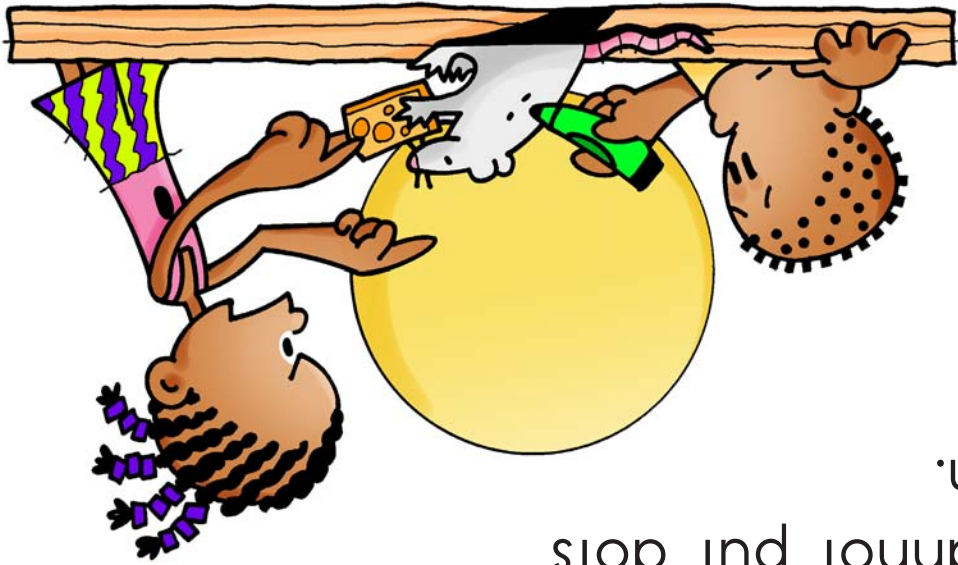


Don sees dots.

and on a pan.

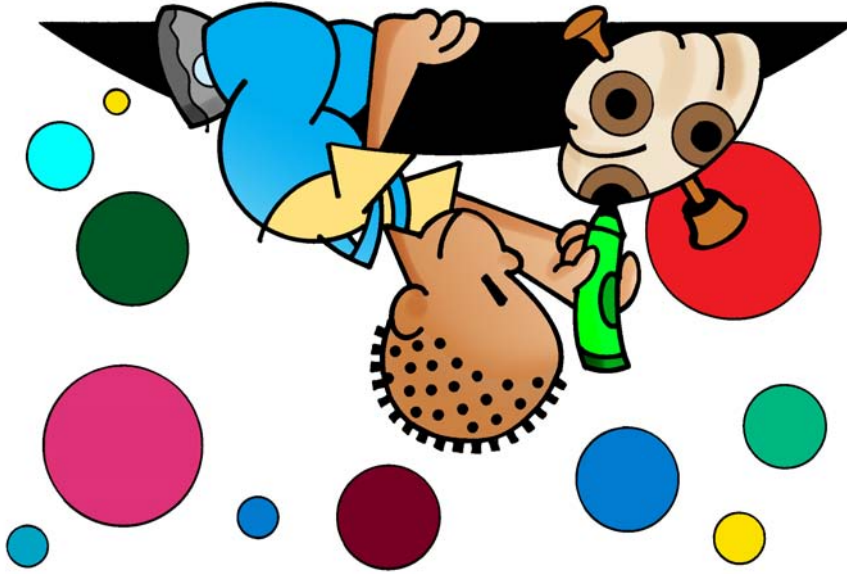


Can Don put dots
