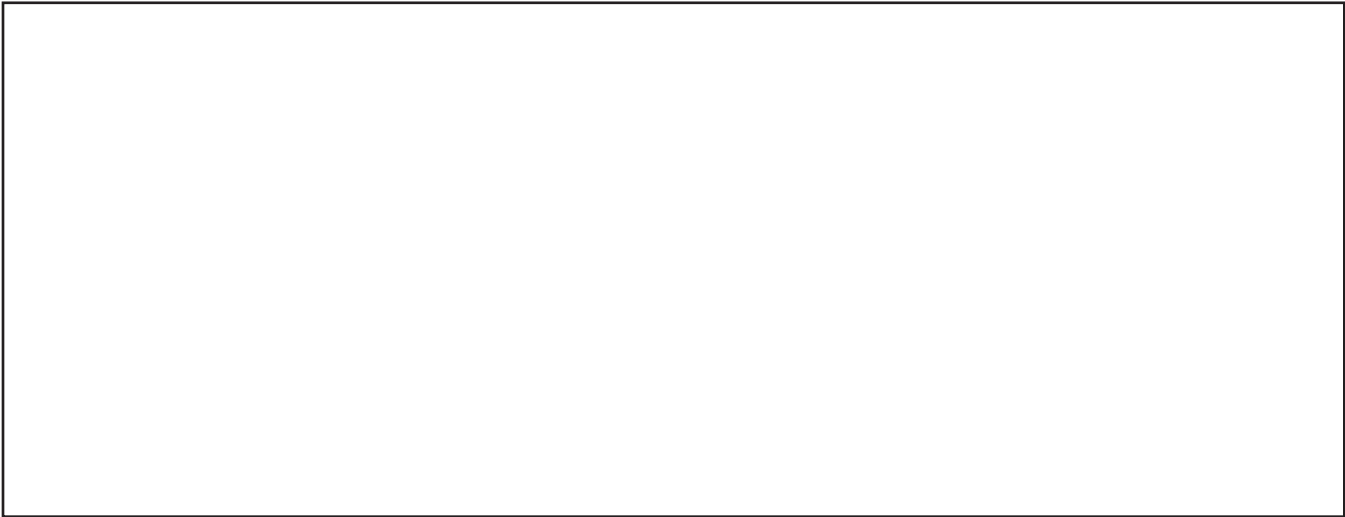

tan on the mat at the dam.



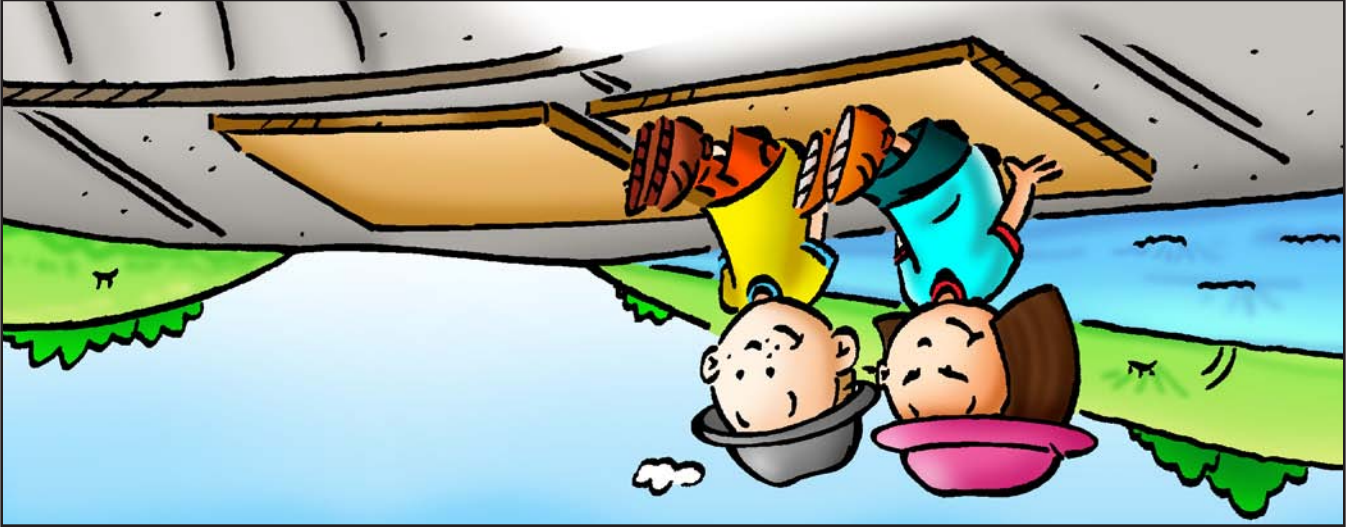
Sam can hop to the dam.
