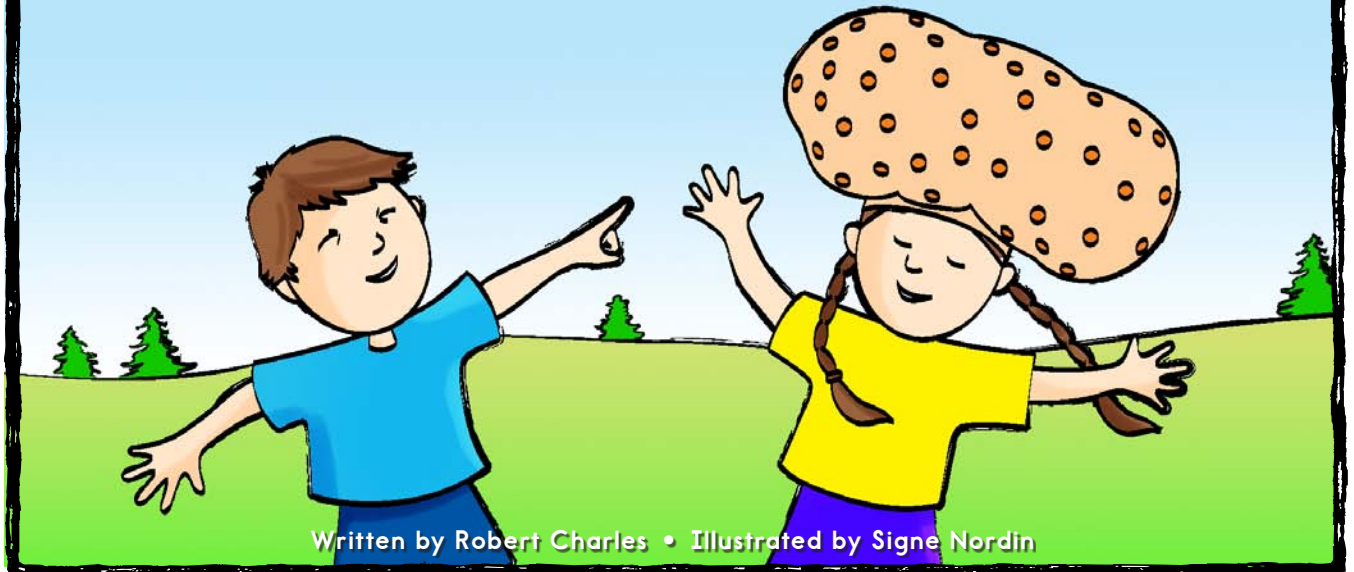

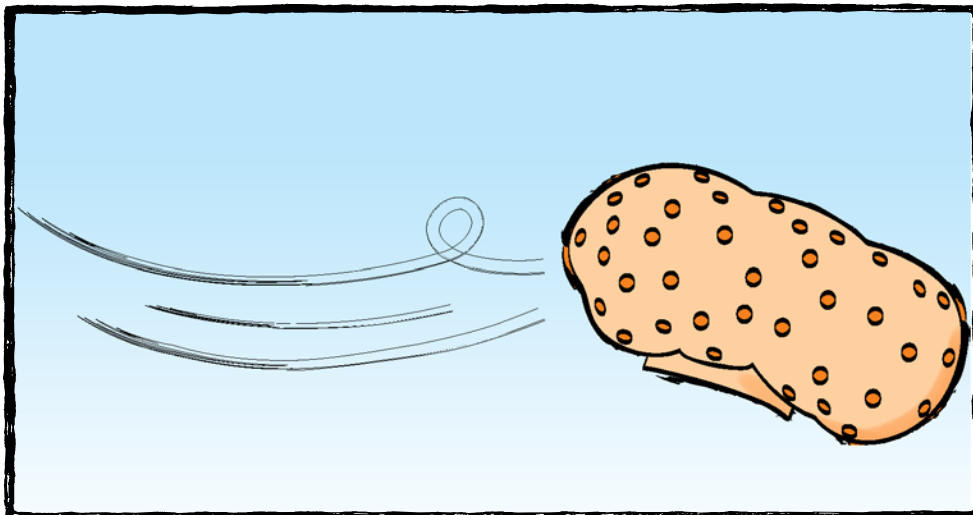

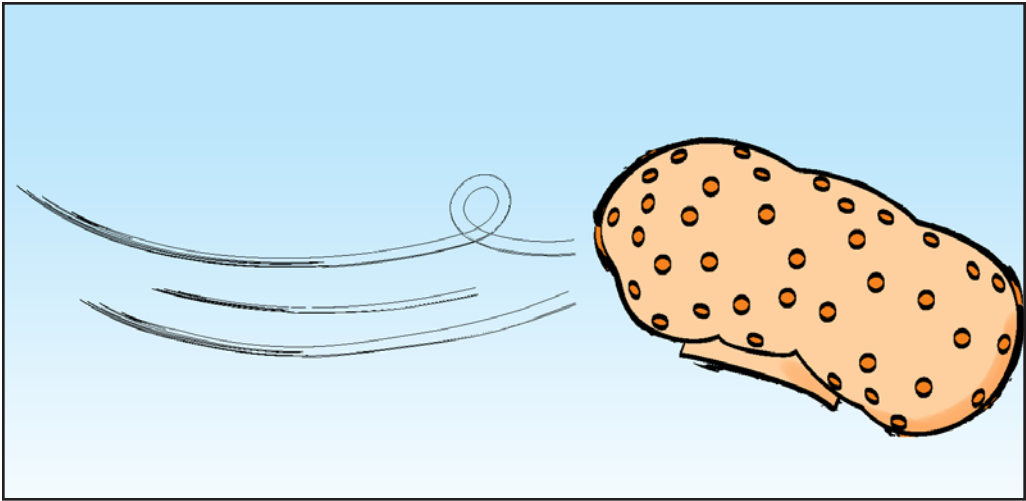

Words with new phonic element *fad, fan, fat*

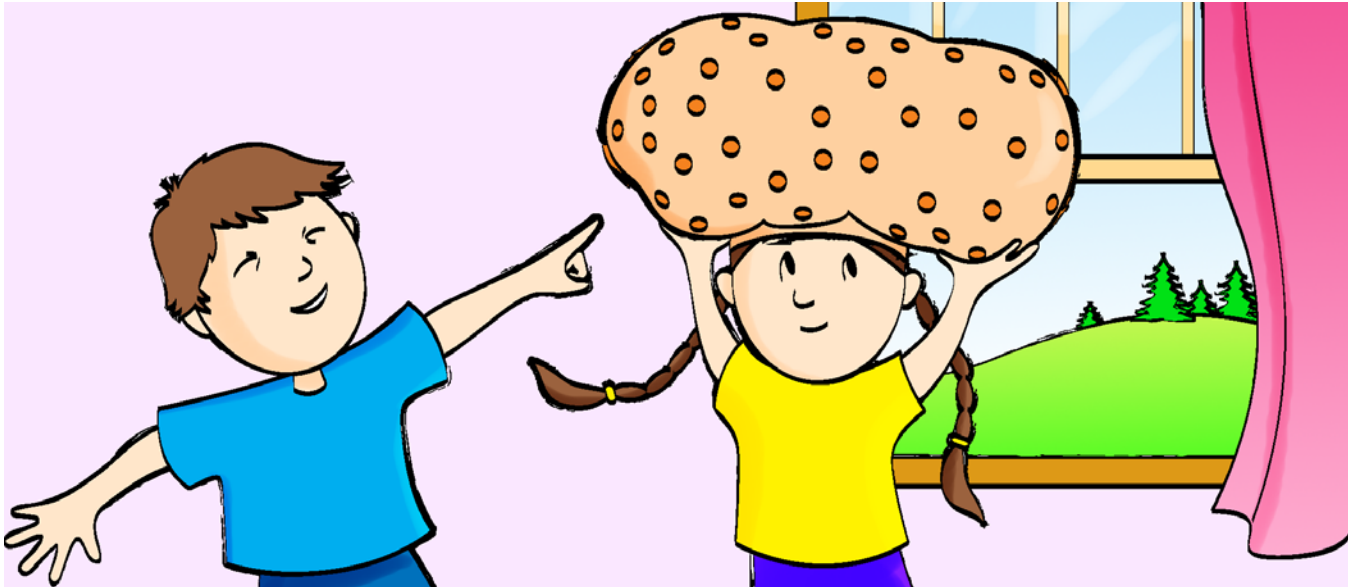
Reviewed phonic elements *n, a, p, m, s, t, o, d, h*

inflectional ending -s



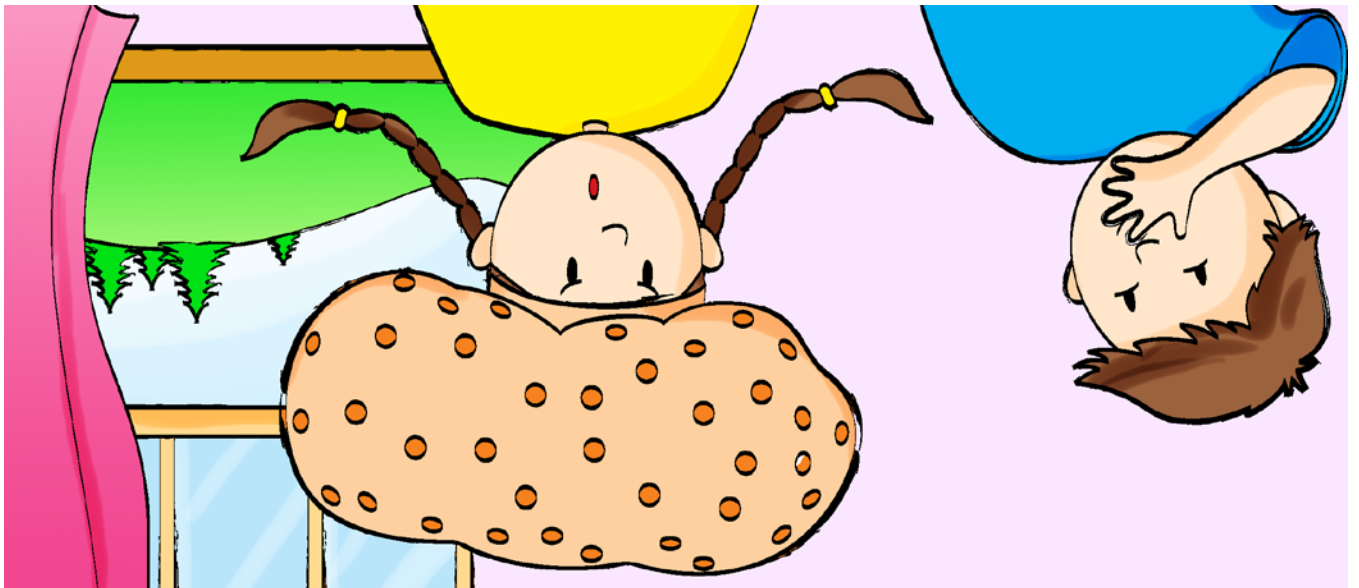
The hat is on Pam.
 “That hat is fat,” said Tom.

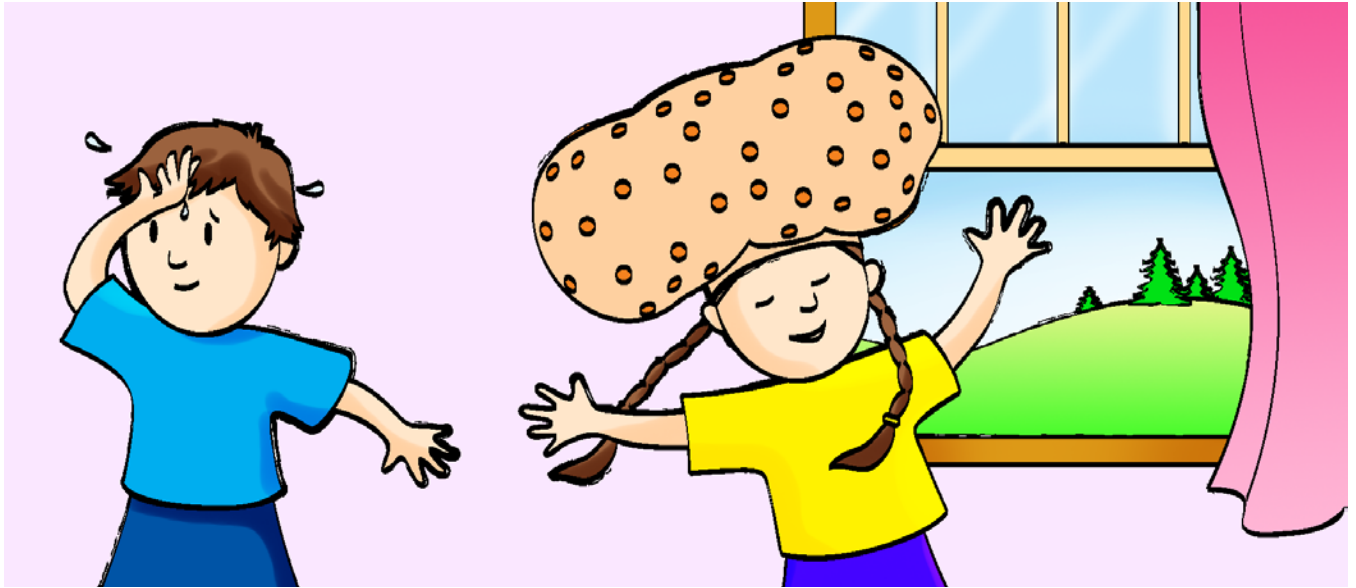

 “It has dots.”





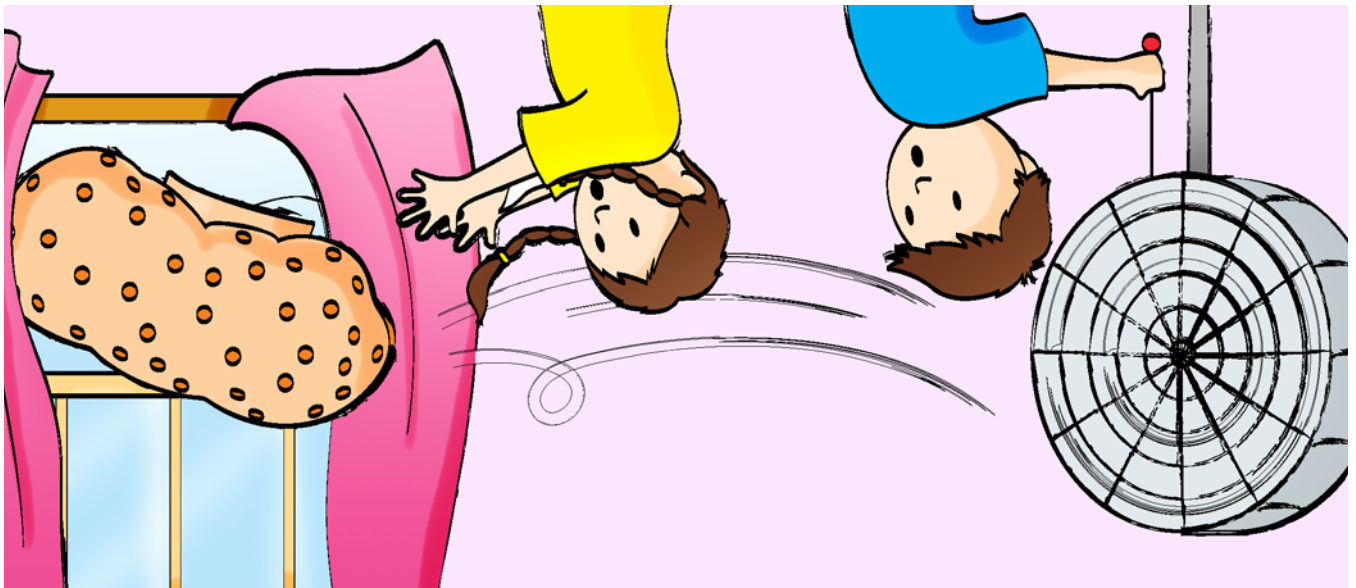
Pam said, “A hat that has dots
is the fad.”

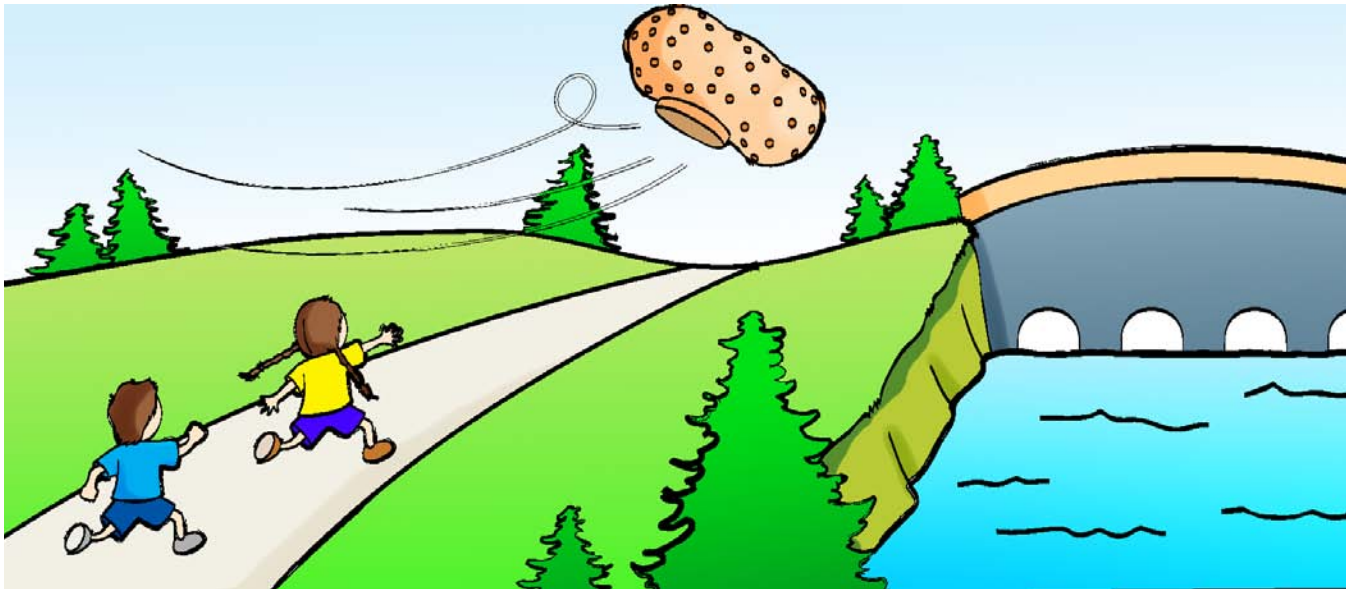

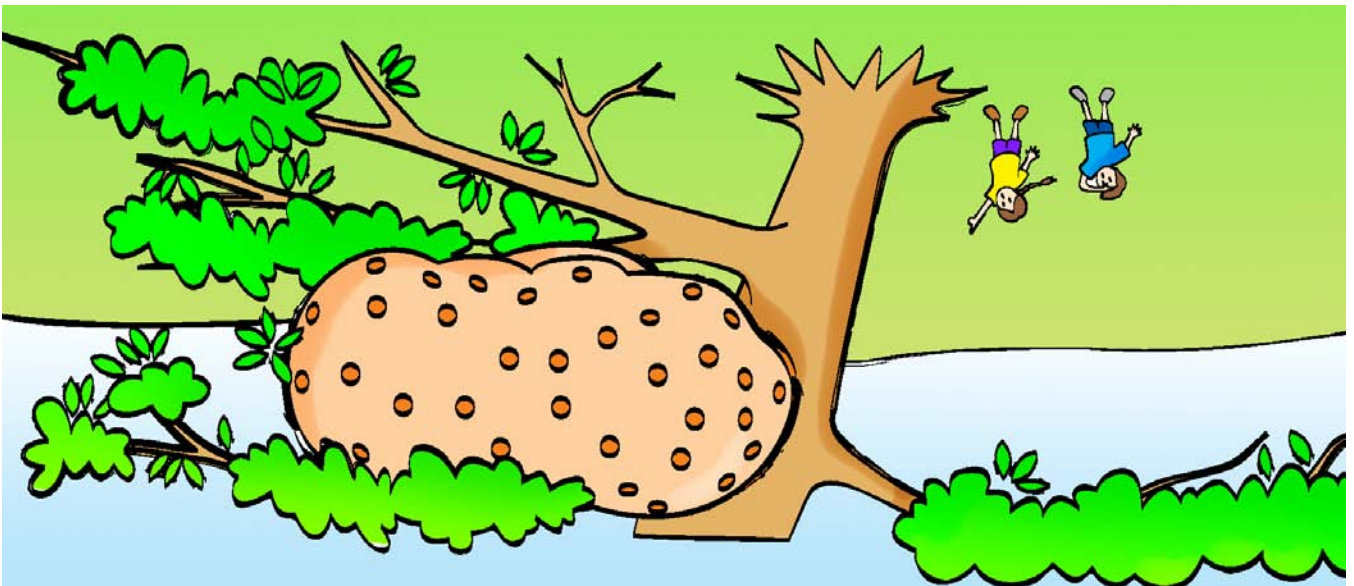
The fan goes on.
Off goes the fat hat.

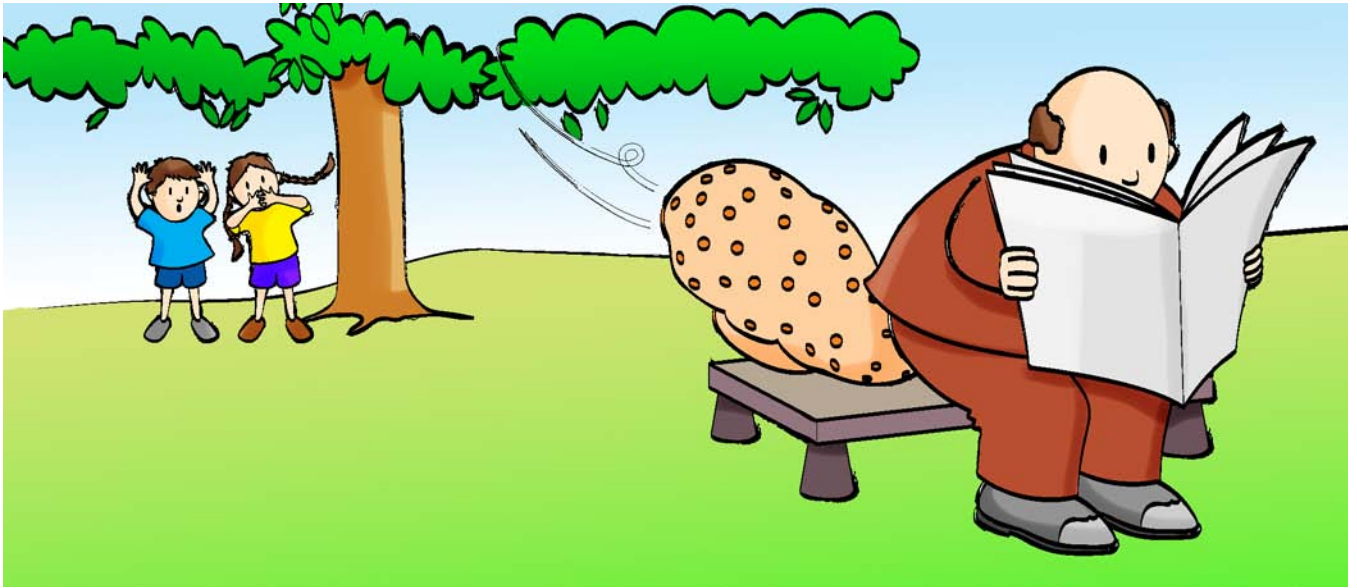




Pam and Tom run to get the hat.
