- New high-frequency words go, play, take
- Reviewed high-frequency words cannot, in, jump, like, put, of, off, on, she, the, they, to, with
- Special considerations inflectional ending –s: plural ending –s; double consonants (Bill)

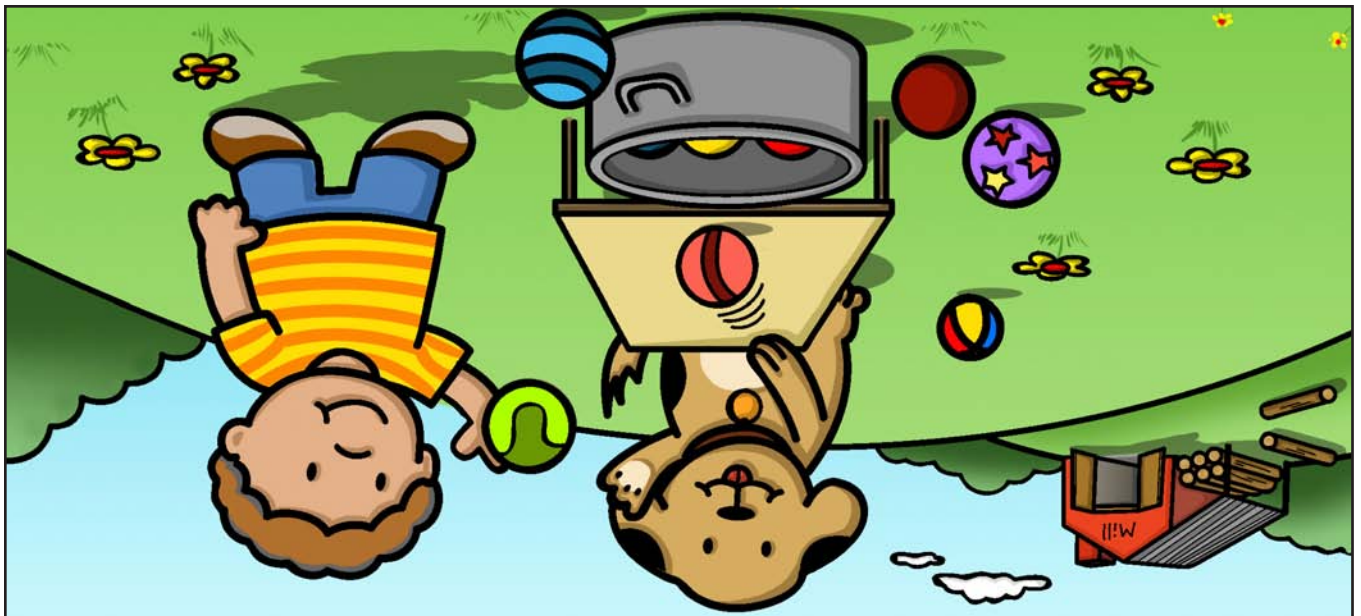
Lil likes to play with Bill.
