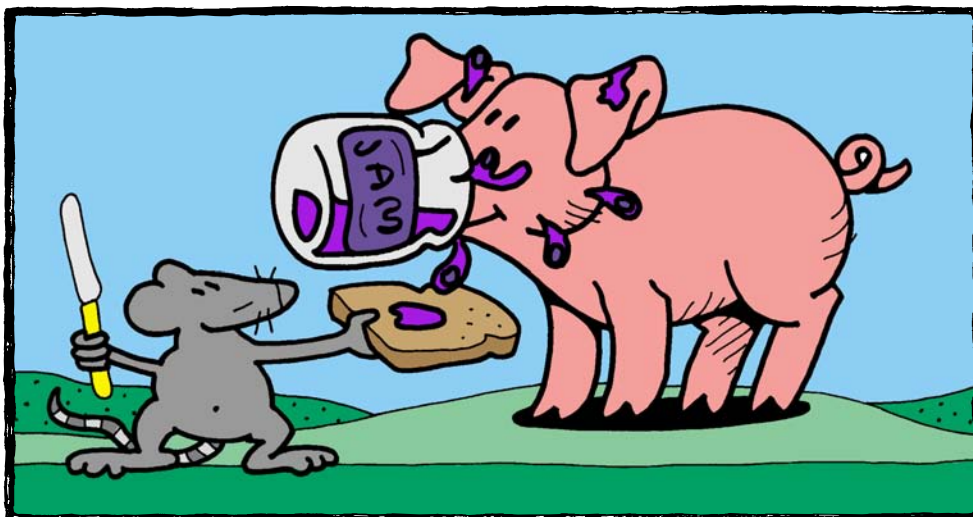

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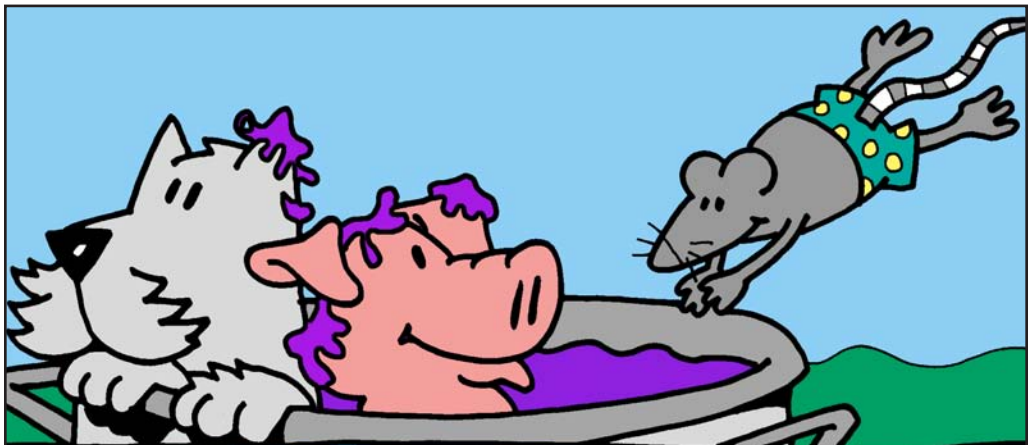

New phonic element *j*

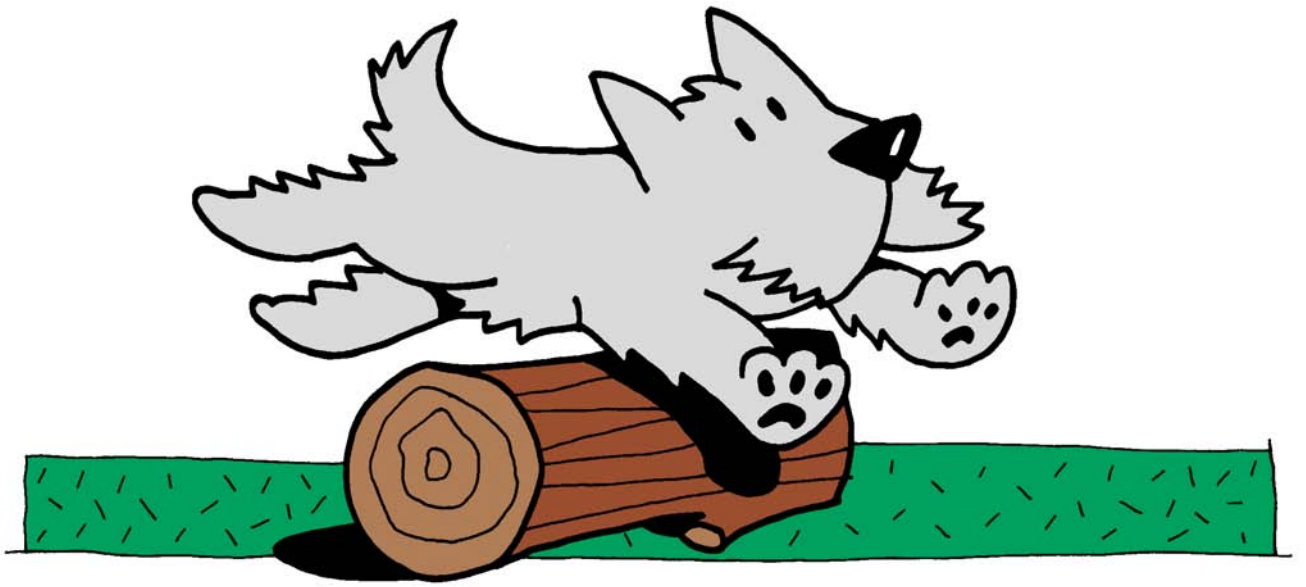
Words with new phonic element *jag, jam, jig, Jim, jog*

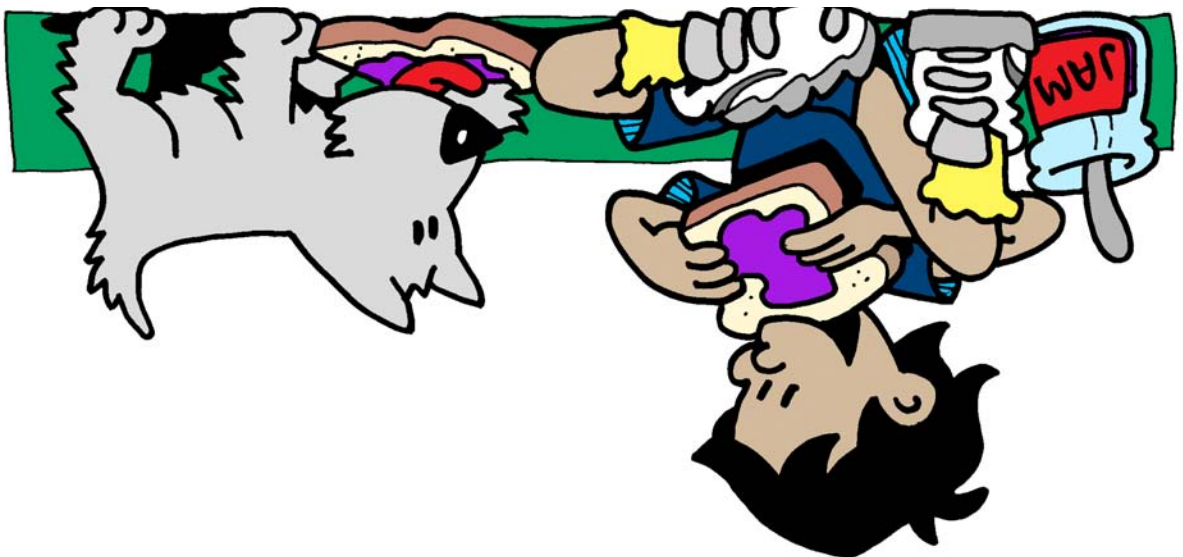

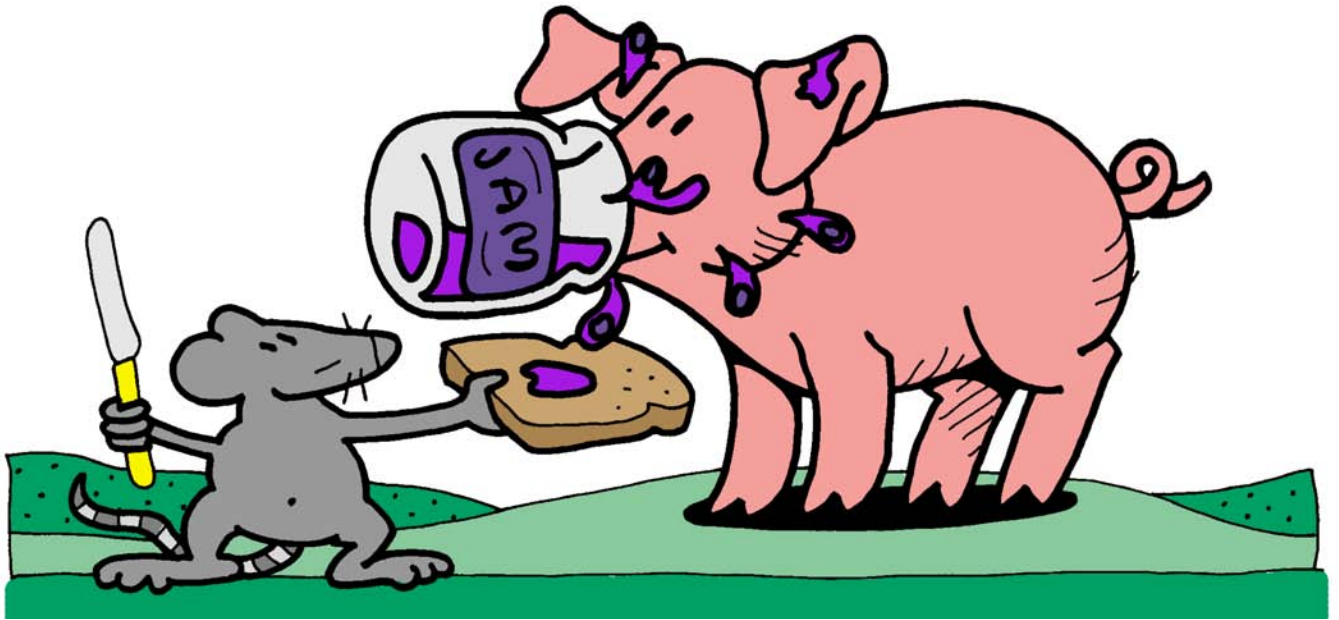

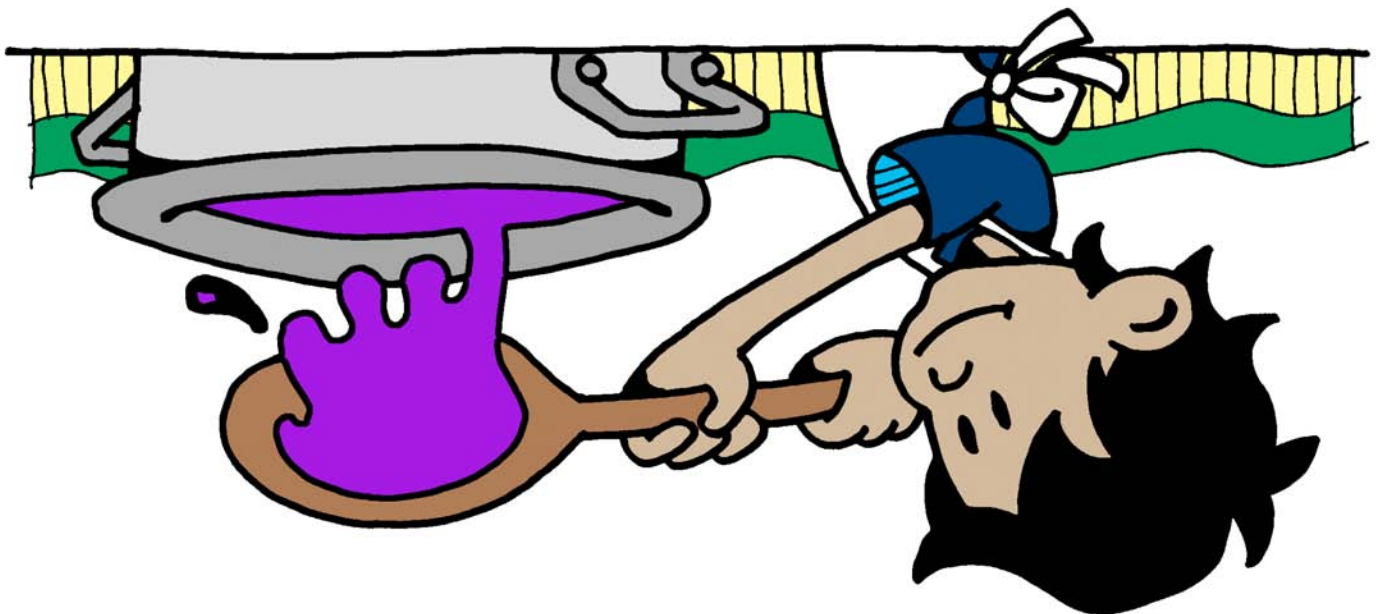
