The dog jumped over a log.

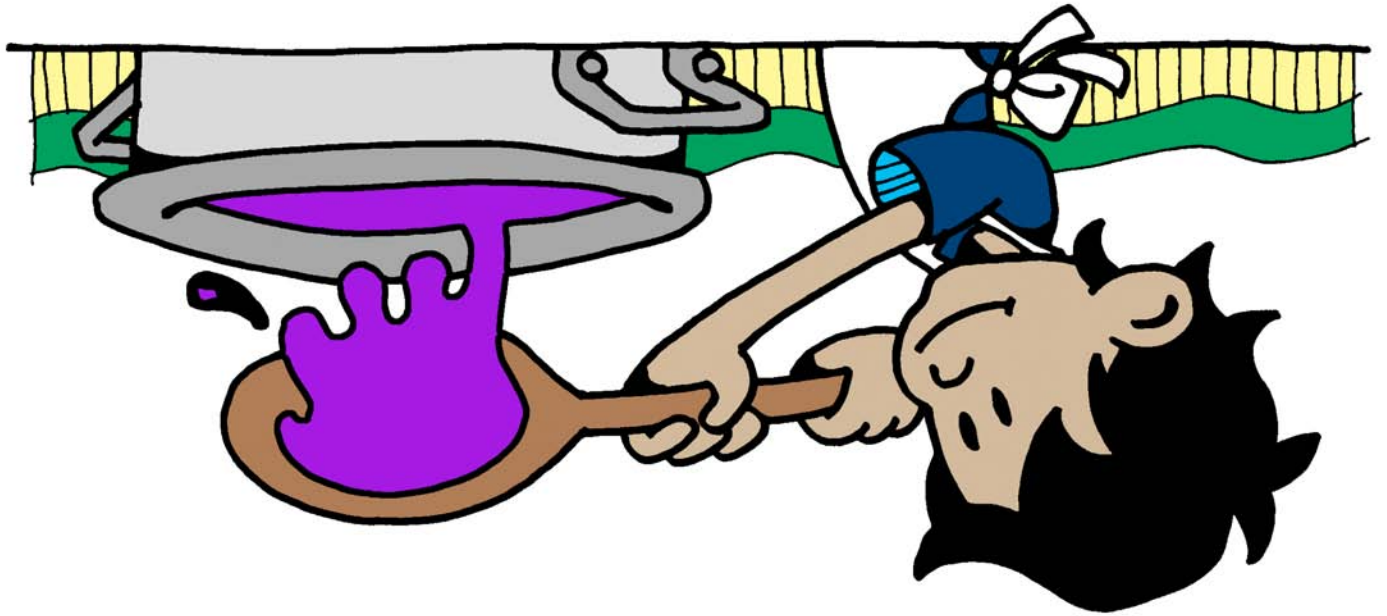
The dog and the pig

The dog jumped in a bog.

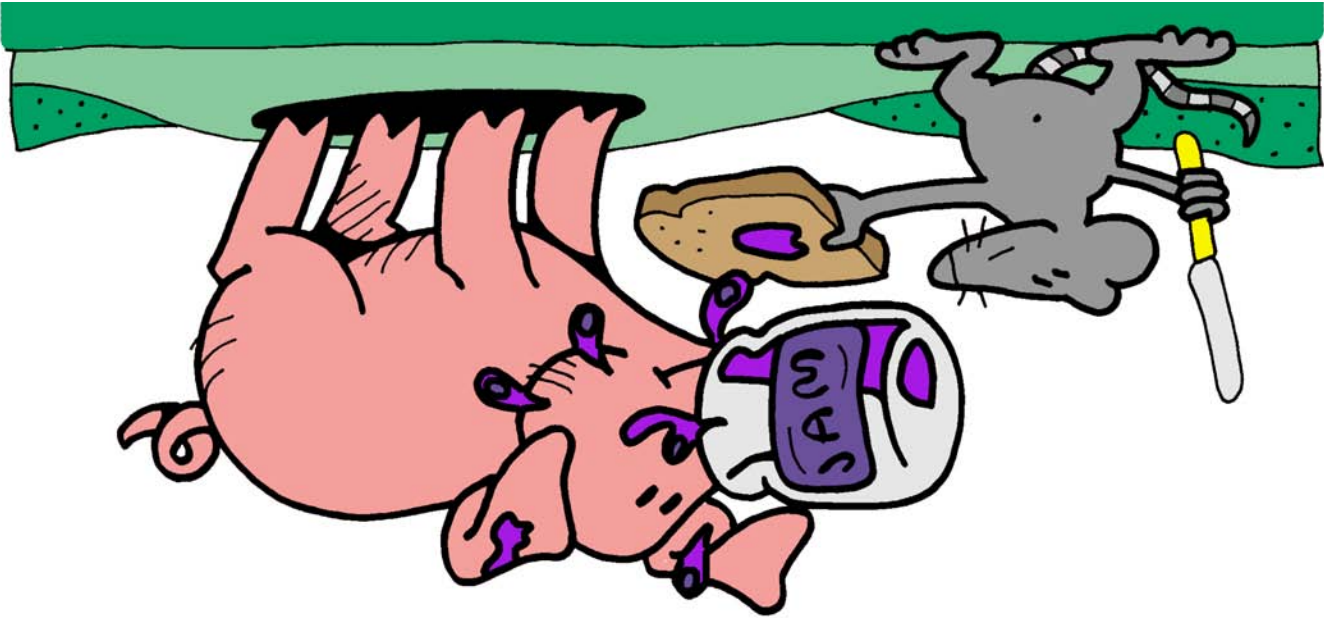


A jig, a jag, and a jot.
