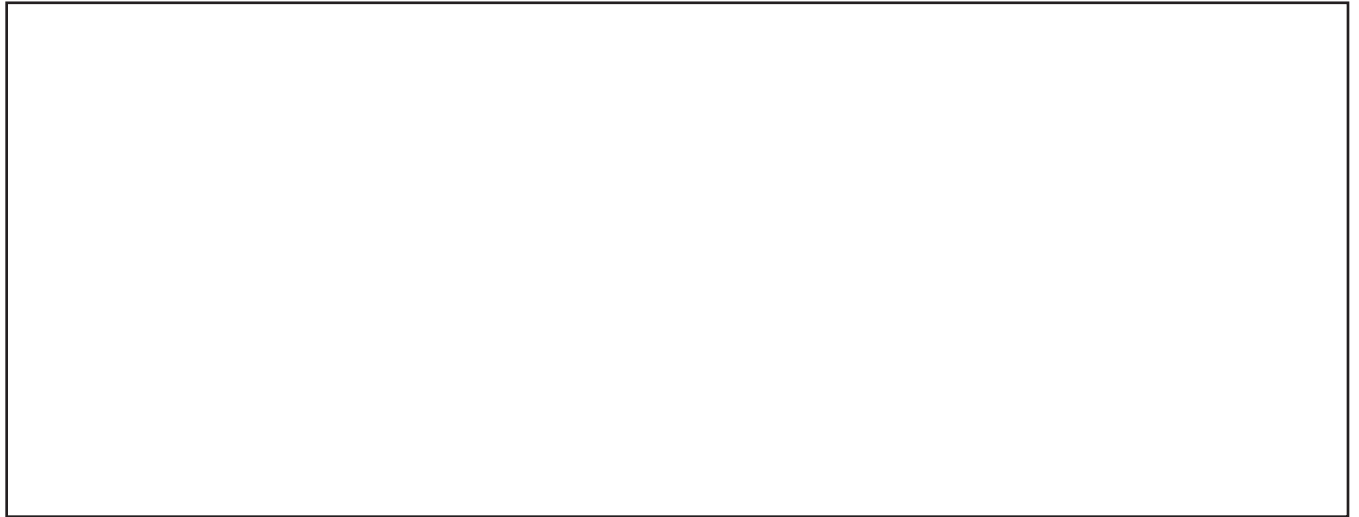

“I will not quit.”



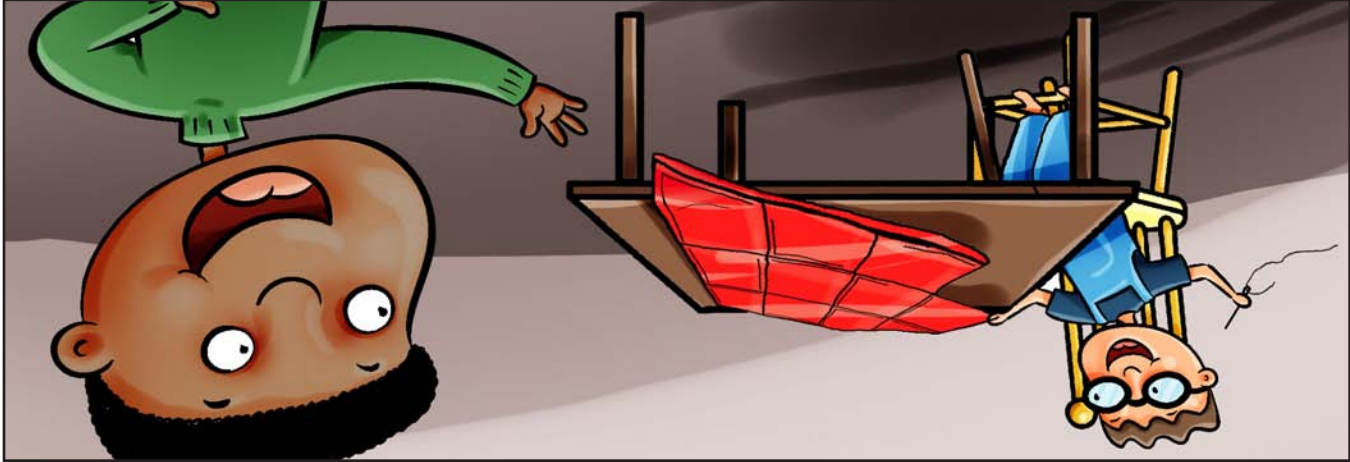
