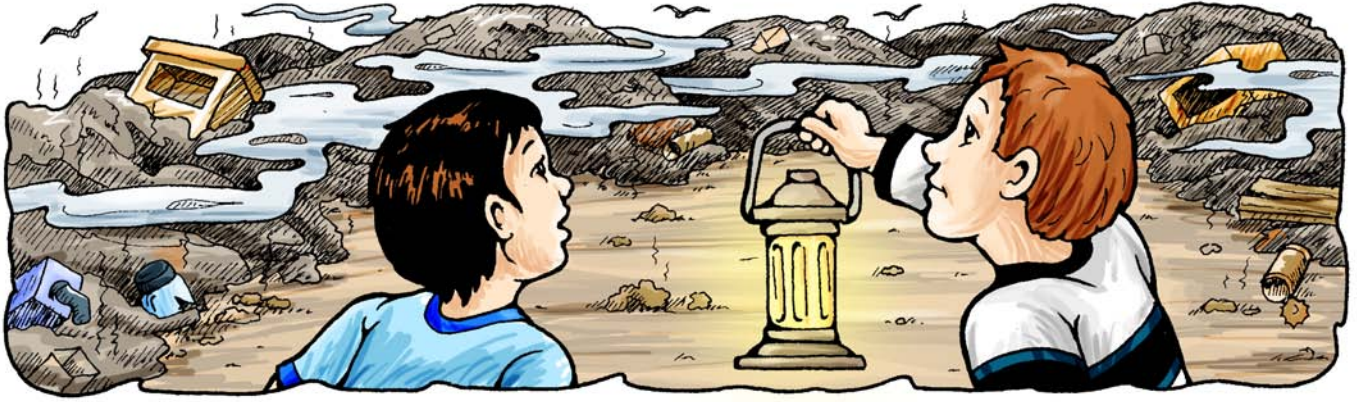

ELEMENTS USED IN THIS BOOK

- New phonic elements** final blends: -ft, -ld, -lp, -lt, -mp
Words with new phonic element dump, felt, held, help, jump, lift, limp, lump, pump, ramp, stomp, stump
- Reviewed phonic elements** initial and final blends:
short vowels; consonants
- Story words** bike, stick, stinky
- New high-frequency words** could, don't, so
- Special considerations** contractions: double consonants:
inflectional endings -ed, -er, -ing, s:
possessive 's; plural ending -s
