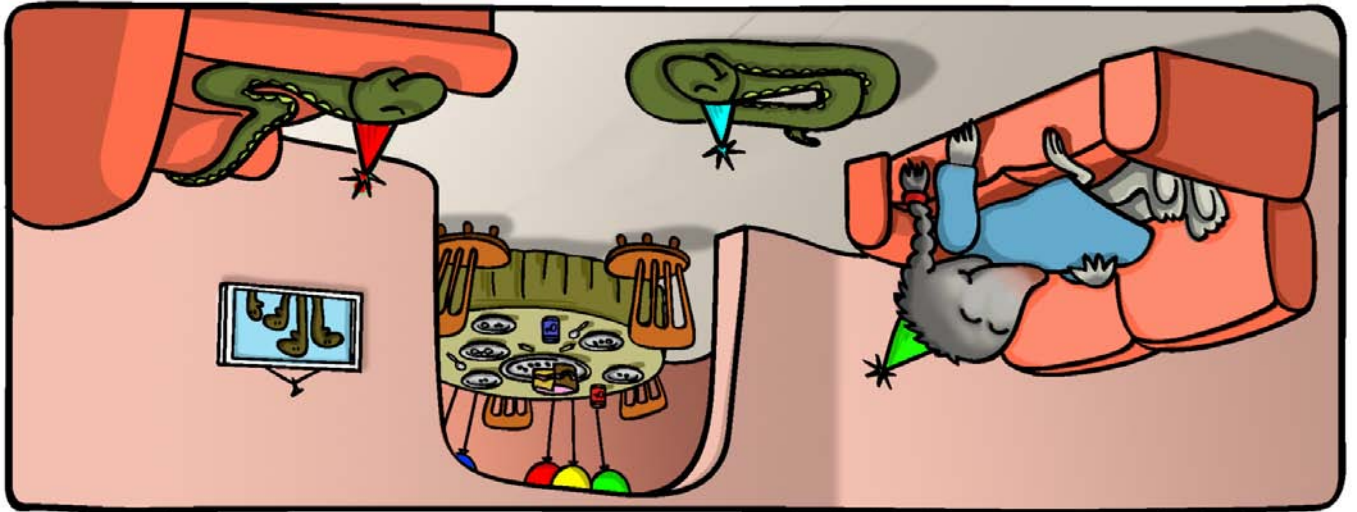

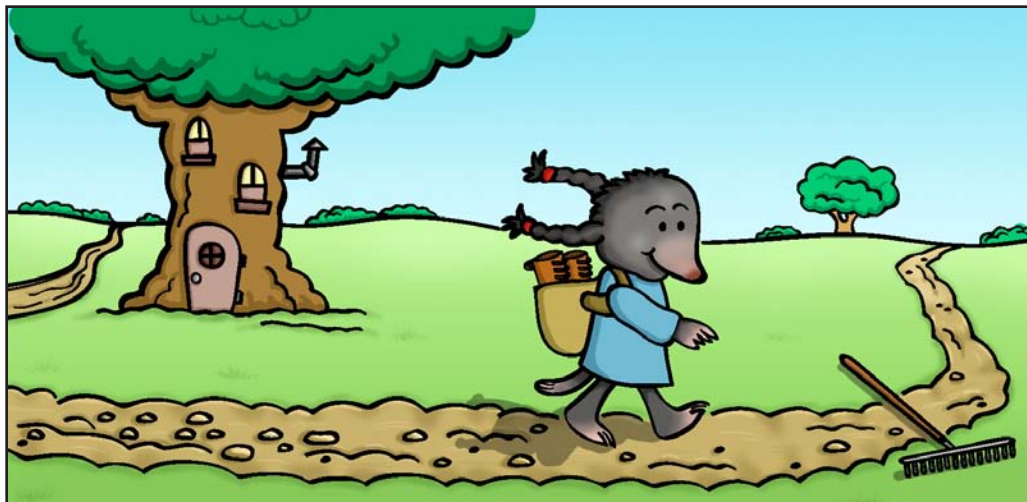

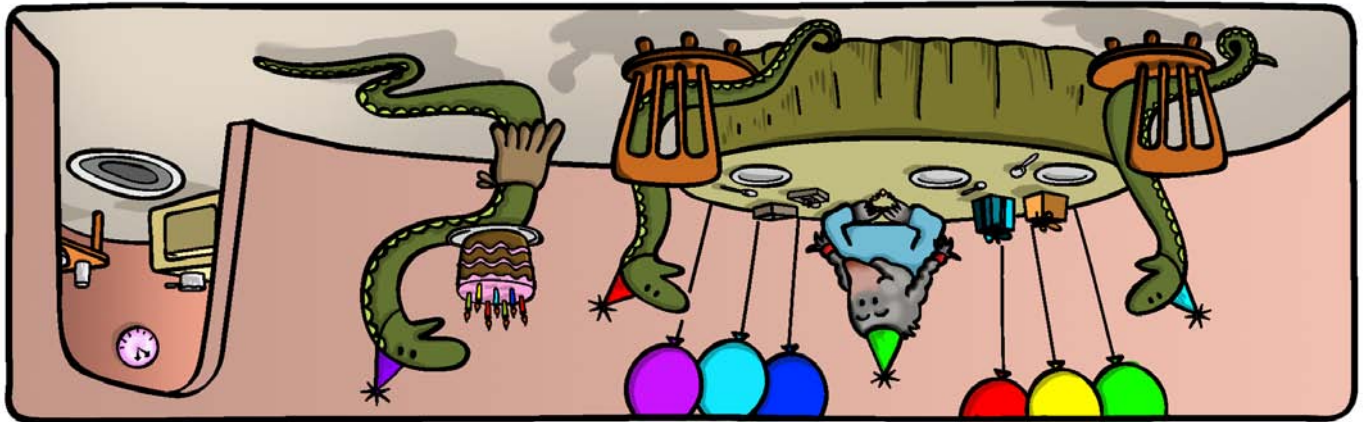
Reviewed phonic elements initial and final blends;

contractions; possessive apostrophe 's

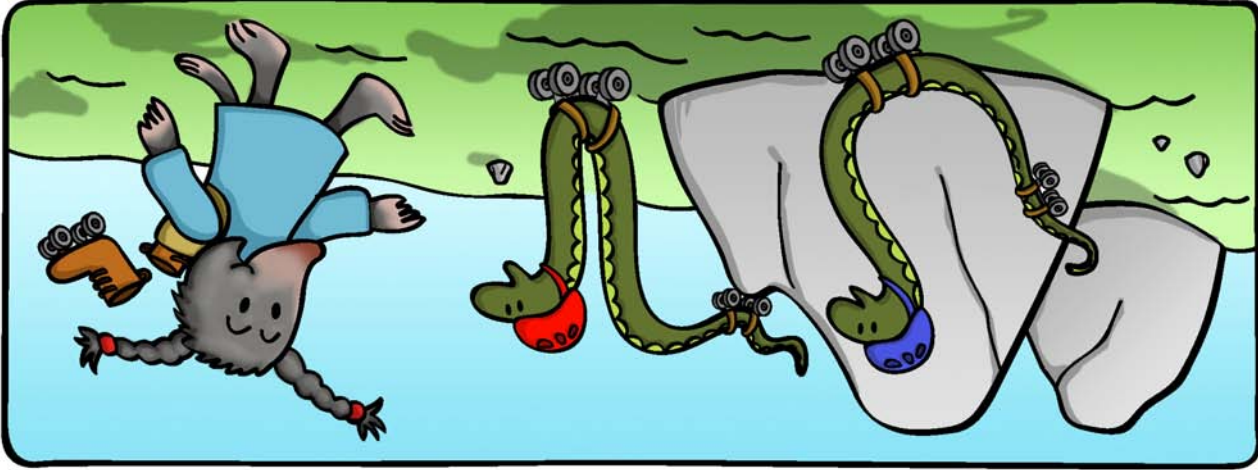
Jane and Jake gave Rose

She poked her nose out of a hole.

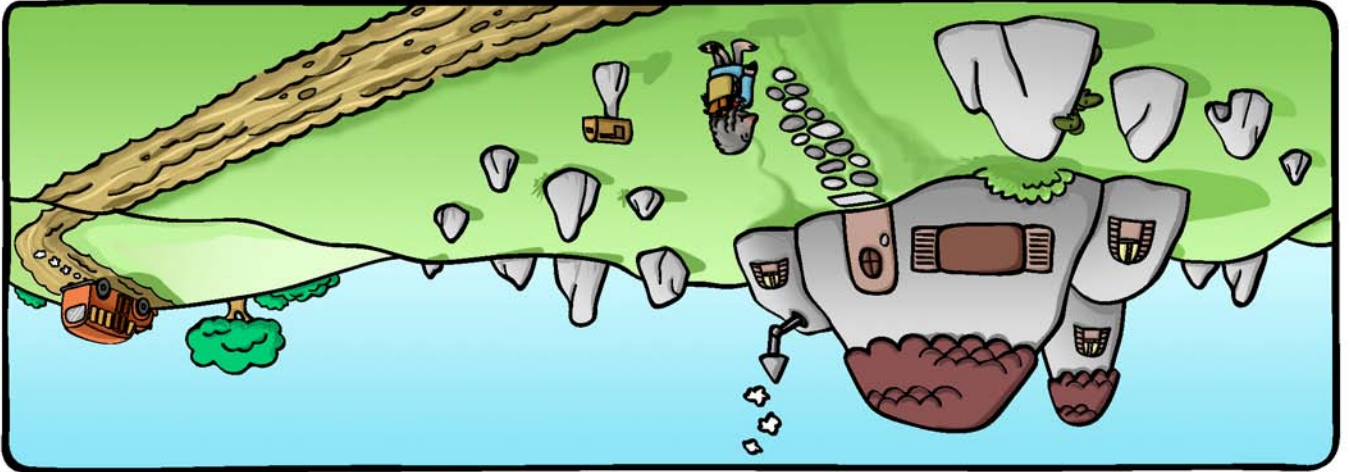
"It is my birthday," she said.
