

**Reviewed phonic elements** long vowel VCe patterns; consonant digraphs sh, ch

**New high-frequency words** funny, now, other



**Special considerations** inflectional endings -ed, -ing, -s; plural ending -s; possessive 's;

 They live in a stack of grass.


Can we trade the click, cluck, and quack?

They said he made too much racket.


This made Chuck sad.

“This duck says cluck and not quack.”



“How funny,” thought Chuck.

Instead, Vick went click, click.


“Hello,” said Jack with a cluck.
