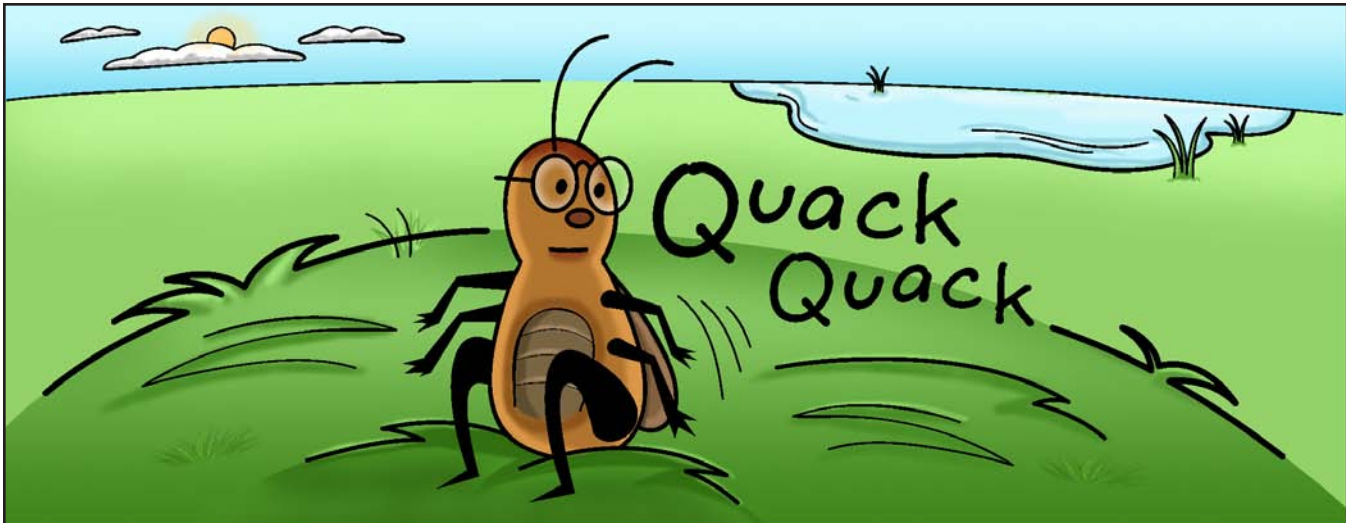
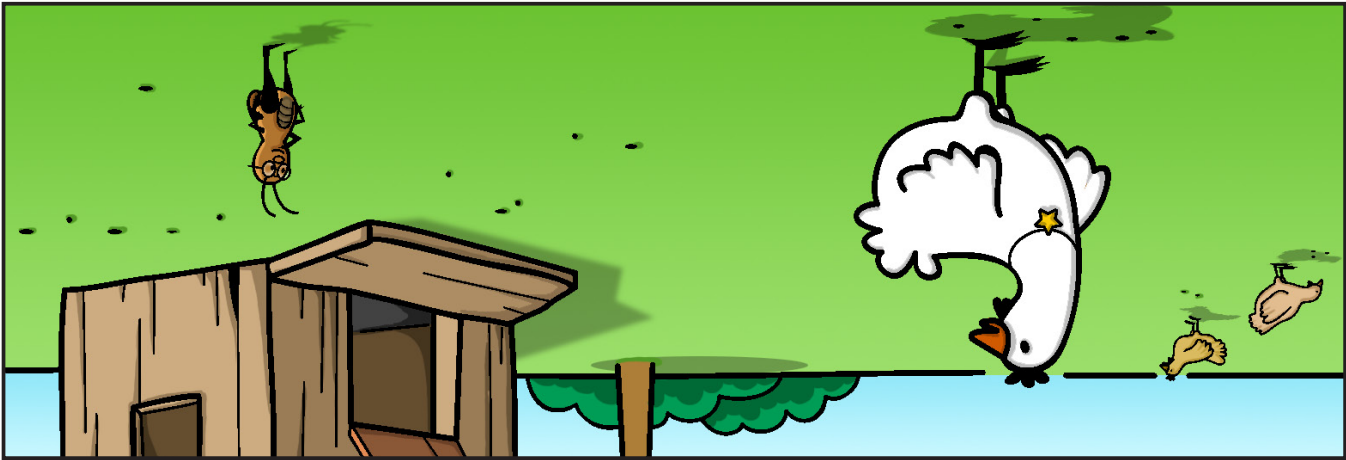
Special considerations inflectional endings *-ed, -ing, -s*; plural ending *-s*; possessive *'s*;

 Now no one was sad.



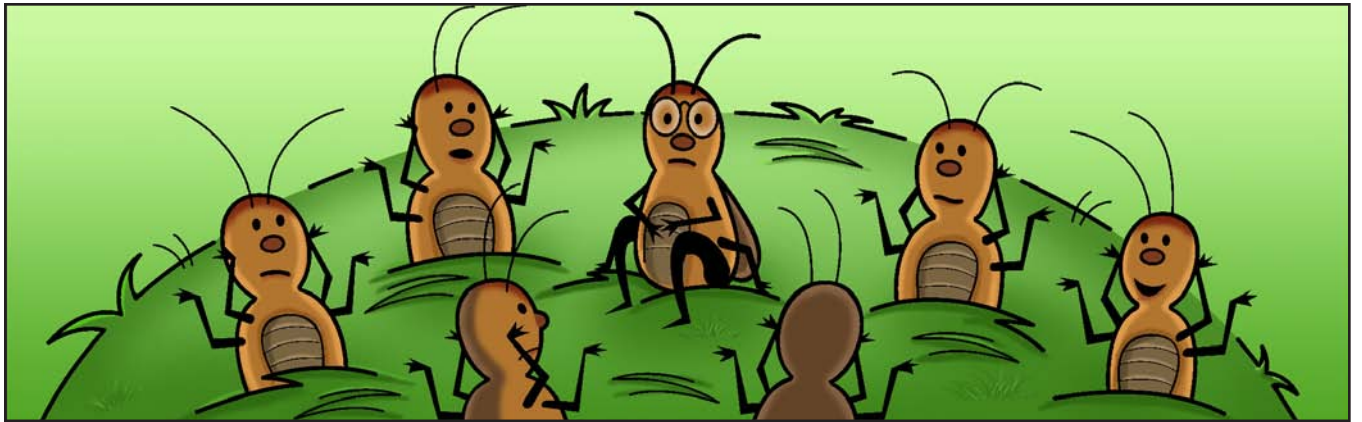
Chuck is a cricket.

 They said he made too much racket.

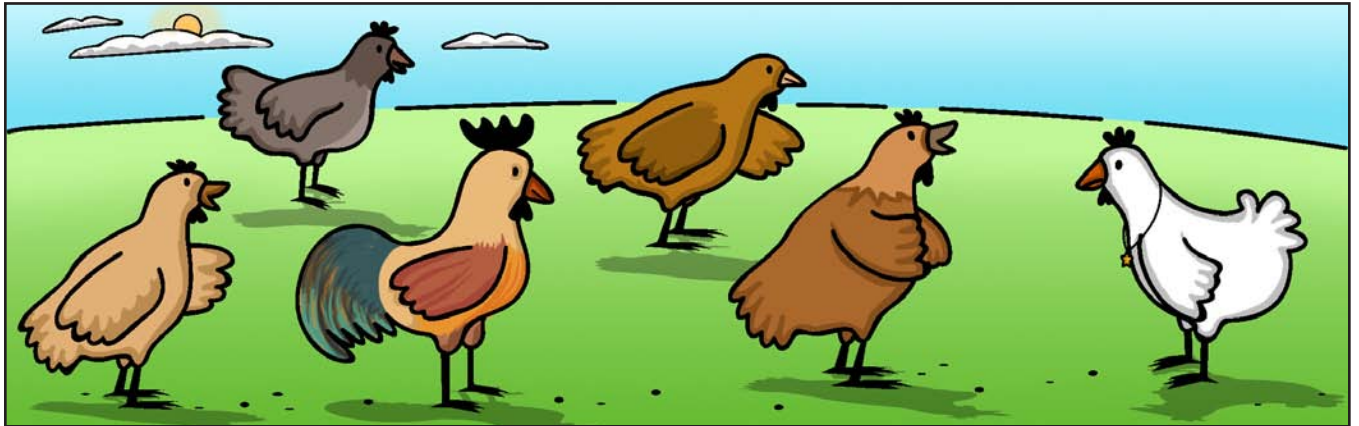
This made Chuck sad.
