Special considerations	inflectional endings -ed, -er, -ing, -s; possessive 's



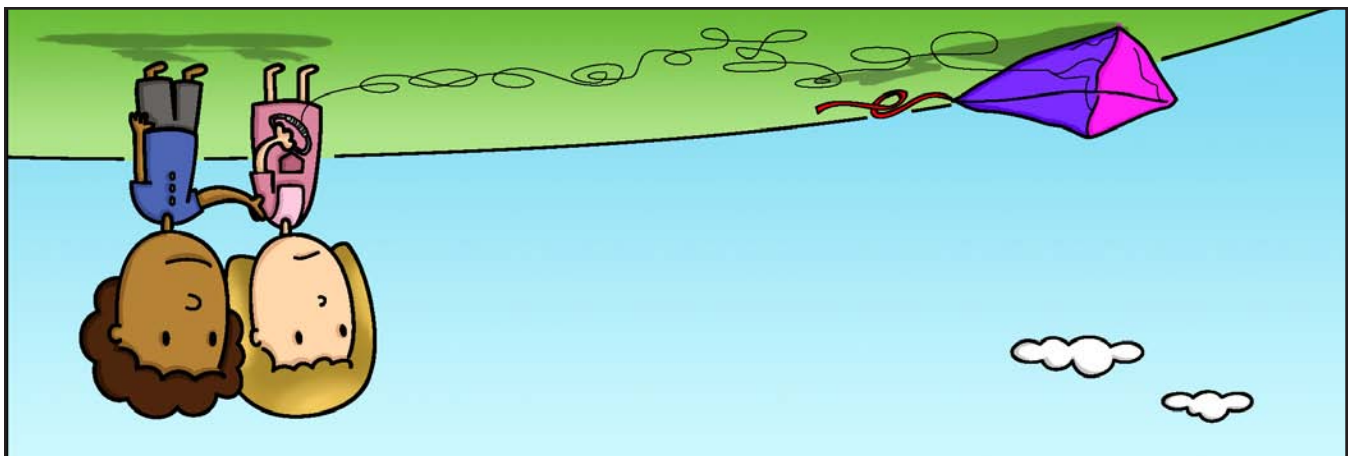
JoJo was very shy.

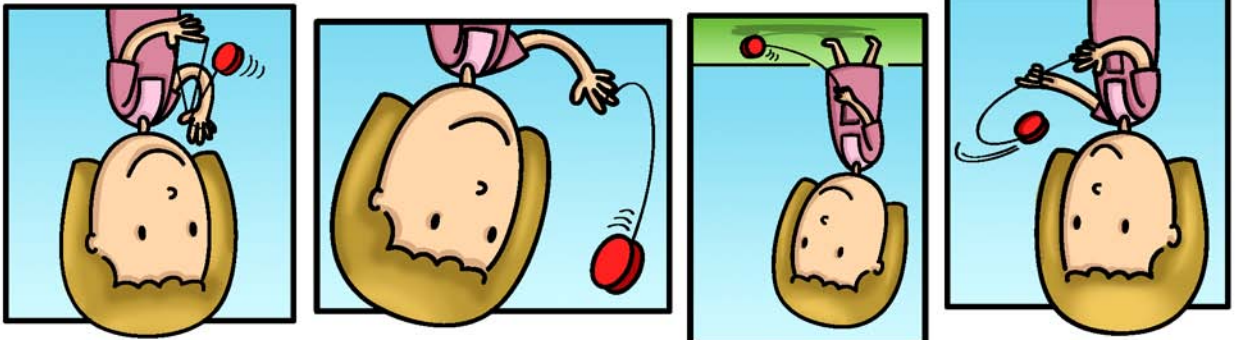
JoJo was so sad.

gave her a yo-yo.

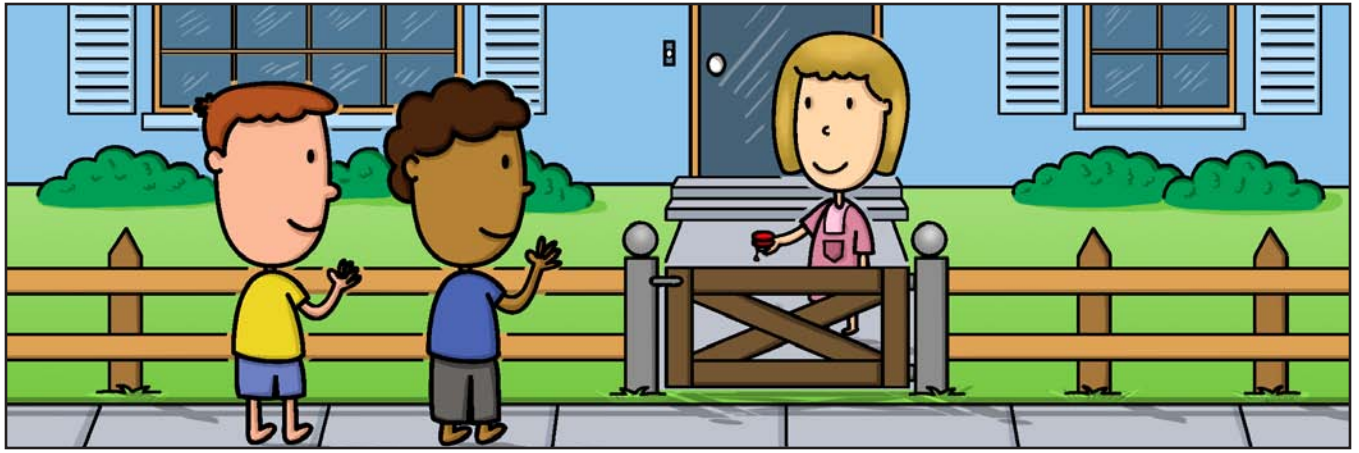

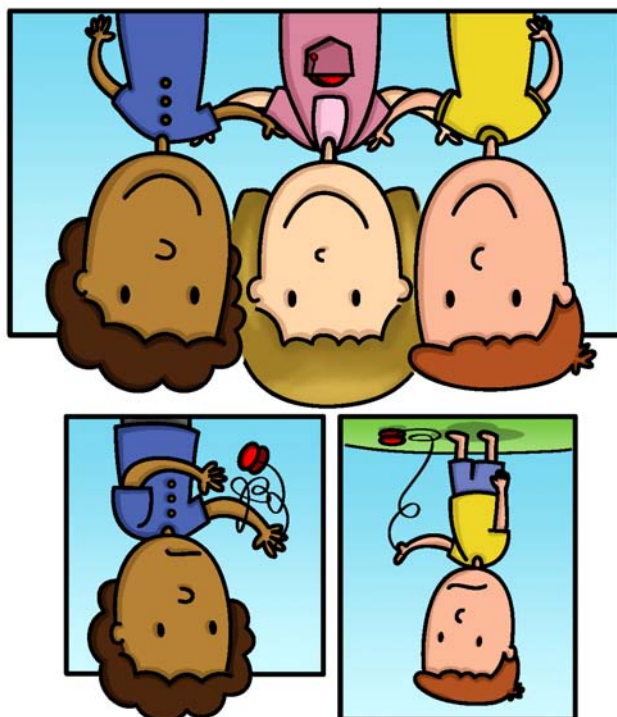


Ty and Flo came by to see JoJo.
