



She was just too shy.


So she did not run fast.

He won lots of races.


Ty could run so fast.

JoJo wanted to fly a kite too.







JoJo's Yo-Yo • Open Vowels

JoJo did yo-yo tricks.







Ty and Flo came by to see JoJo.
