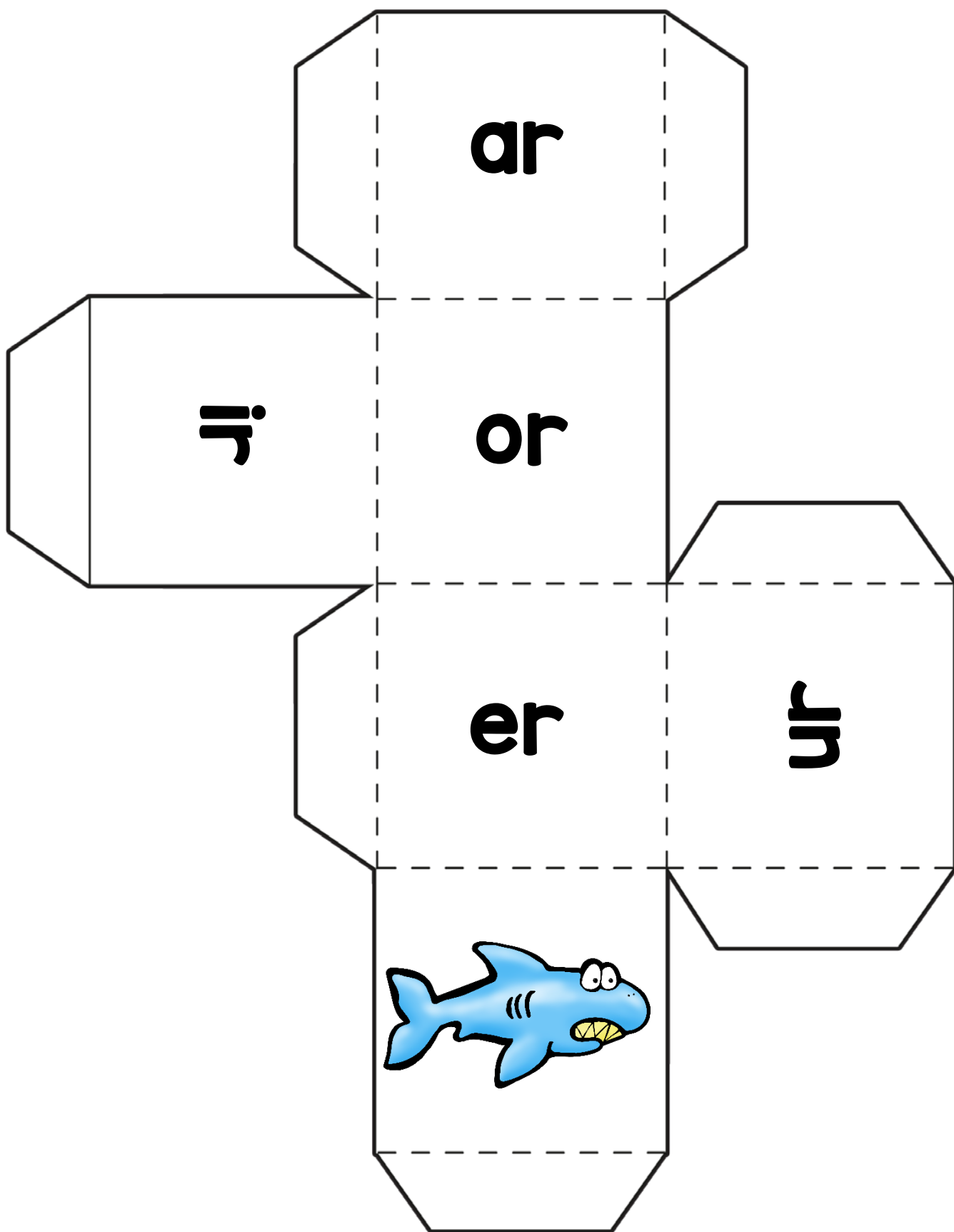
JUMP THE SHARK!

laminated per player,**

Directions:

- 1. ON A TURN: Roll the game cube.**
- 2. LAND ON ANY SIDE: Choose one word to read from a box with that r-controlled vowel. Cross it out with an X.**
- 3. LAND ON THE SHARK: Say, "SHARK!"
ERASE one of the Xs you used on one word.**
- 4. The first person to cross out five words (anywhere on the board) wins the round.**
- 5. Erase the game board, and play again!**



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
