“The Kitty Cat” Spelling Rule

- C usually comes before
a, o or u.

example: cat, cop, cub

- K usually comes before
e and i.

example: kept, kid

- Or after l, s, or n.

example: skill, desk, bunk,
milk



Kitty Cat left at dusk to scan the trash. She did spot a mask next to the bank that some kid left. Kitty Cat did wish to spot a cod fish and some milk, not a mask.

Clink, clank went the lid on a trash can. “It was Ken!” said Kitty Cat. She did skip to Ken’s shop. Ken had on a cap. He gave Kitty Cat a wink and she gave him a kiss. Kitty Cat was not Ken’s pet, but he fed her a lot.


