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
How To Play Pancake Syllables

Materials: pages 4-7, cut out, one copy of page 7 per player, paper clip and pencil for spinner, 16 pancakes, cut out, dry erase board, marker and eraser, spatula

1. Spread the 16 pancakes out in a 4 by 4 array.
2. Decide who will go first.
3. Place page 7 in front of each player.
4. Take turns spinning the spinner. On a turn, spin the spinner.
 - Land on 'pan' = Choose one pancake to read out loud and place it in the pan.
 - Land on 'divide' = Choose one pancake to read out loud, spell it out loud on your white board, and divide correctly into syllables. If you do all these steps correctly, you may place that pancake on your plate.
 - Land on 'flip' = Take out any pancakes in the pan and read them out loud. Place them on your plate. If there are no pancakes in the pan, skip a turn.
 - Land on 'plate' = Choose one pancake to read out loud, and place it on your plate.
5. The person with the most pancakes on their plate wins!
