Gifts For The Party!


Pick up gifts for the party.




Materials: Game board, word cards (shuffled), white board, marker, and eraser (optional), one, 6-sided, number cube

Directions

1. Decide who will go first.
2. Roll the number cube.
3. Have your partner choose a word card that has the same final blend as the one on that space. They will read the word to you.
4. Spell the word correctly out loud or write it correctly on a white board.
5. If you spell it correctly, you may move ahead the number of spaces you rolled on the number cube.
6. If you were incorrect, please try again.
7. Players switch turns and repeat directions 2-6.
8. Keep playing until you both reach home.
9. If you land on GIFT, you get to move ahead a
