









What Is An Initial L Blend?

An initial L blend is a group of two consonants at the beginning of a word.

Each consonant in a blend makes its own sound.

Ex. plug

The plan was to not slip and flip on the sled. Bess and Miss Bass got on the sled and did whiz on the hill. Not a slip or a flip was had.



FLIP FLOP CONCENTRATION



Materials: 1 set of concentration cards, shuffled and placed face down in a 4x4 array

Directions:

1. Players take turns by turning over two cards. Try to make matches of the same words. A match is when you find two of the **SAME BLEND**.
2. When you make a match, keep both cards. If they don't match, put them back where you found them.
3. The person with the most matches wins!
4. Reshuffle the cards well, and play again.


