Chimp Chat





Object: Build ch words. Be the first person to use up all your puzzle pieces.

Directions

1. Decide who will go first.
2. Each player separates their puzzle pieces in two piles, a pile for the onsets (these are the digraphs) and the rimes.
3. Land on...
 - + : Add one puzzle piece anywhere on your Chop board.
 - CHOP: Take one puzzle piece away.
 - A bandage: Earn one piece back.
 - Puzzle piece: Create one word with your puzzle pieces and place them on an empty space on your Chop board.
