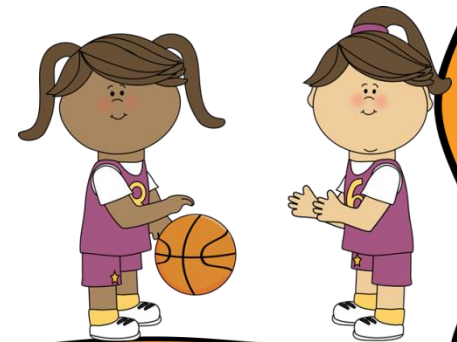
Thank you for your purchase! These activities will really help your students learn about the doubling rule. Here are some helpful tips:

- Use Free Throw BUMP at a center for extra practice with the doubling rule.
- Photocopy the base word cards on pg. 4 to use in a sorting activity.
- Photocopy the sorting chart on pg. 6 for students to write their words correctly with the different suffixes.
- Display the 1+1+1 Doubling Rule Mini-Poster on pg. 7 as a reminder of when to double the final consonant.
- Use the semantic map on pg. 8 as an assessment tool.

# Directions To Play Free Throw BUMP!

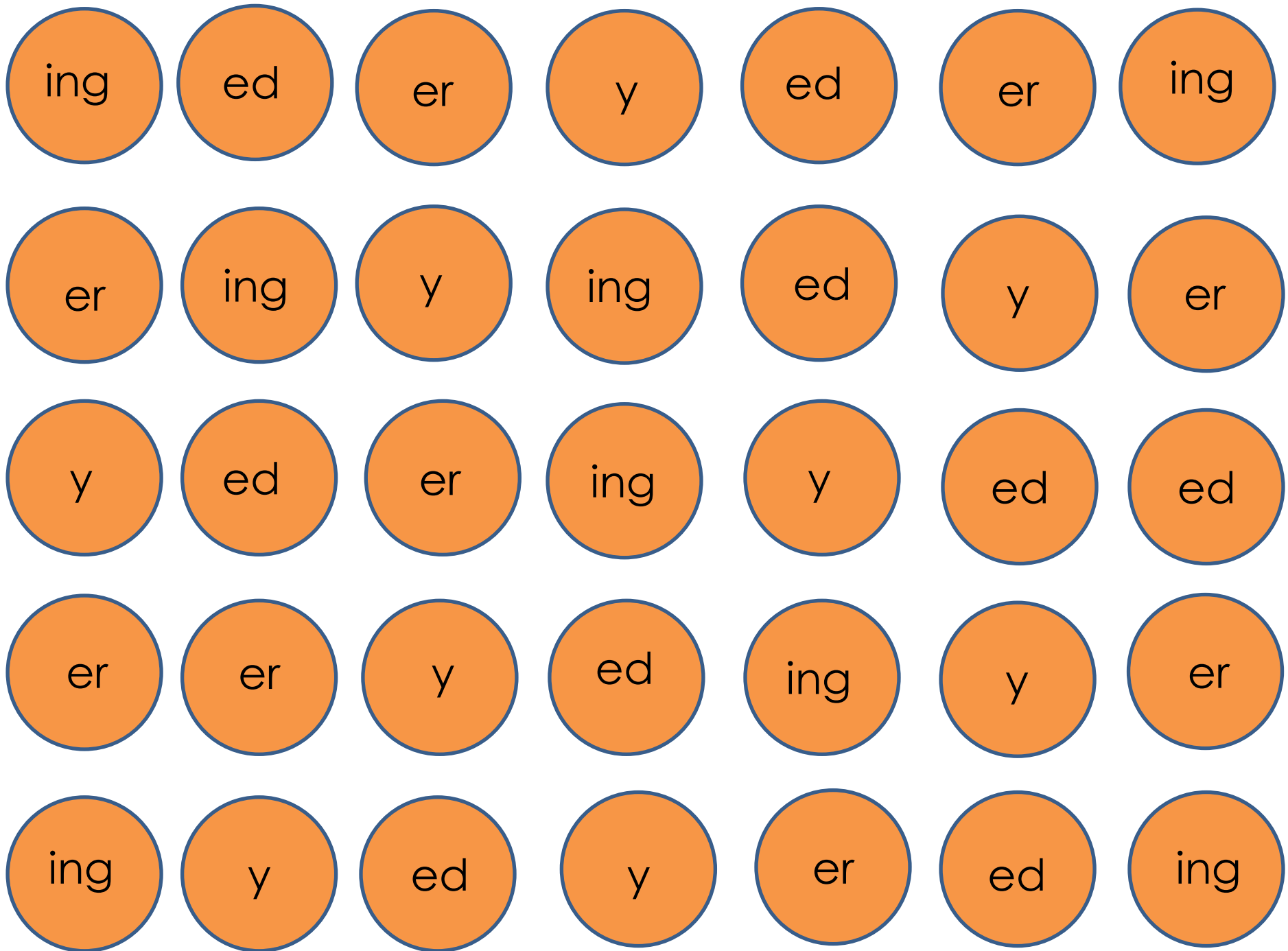
**Materials:** Game board, base word cards, paper and pencil or dry erase board, markers, and eraser, plastic counters or pennies

**Players: 2-4**

**How To Play:**

1. Shuffle the base word cards, including the FREE THROW and DOUBLE DRIBBLE cards and place next to the game board.
2. When it's a player's turn pick up one card and read it.
3. The player will say which suffix circle on the game board they will add to their word.
4. The player writes the word on their paper or board. If it's written correctly they can place a counter or penny on that suffix circle. If they misspell the word they need to try writing it again but will not place a counter or penny on a suffix circle.
5. If a player cannot add a suffix to their word (which could happen as the game gets close to the end), they say, "Pass."
6. If a player draws a "FREE THROW" card they can either pick up a base word card and choose TWO suffix circles to add to it. OR, they can BUMP someone else's chip if it's on a suffix circle that player wants.
7. If a player chooses a "DOUBLE DRIBBLE" card, they lose a turn and remove one of their counters from the game board.
8. When all the suffix circles have been covered, the player with the most counters on the board wins.

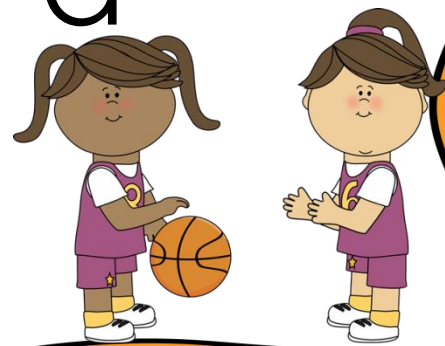
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# The 1 + 1 + 1 Doubling Rule

If a one syllable base word ends in one vowel with one consonant before it, double the final consonant of the base word when you add a suffix that begins with a vowel.

Example: run/running
